



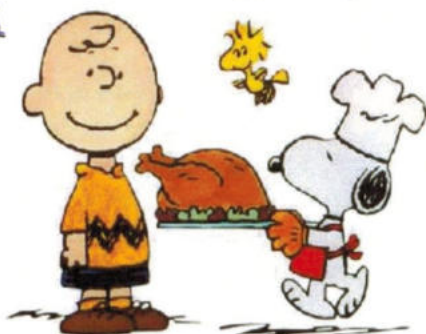

NEFSARDA DELEGATES MEETING MINUTES –JULY 14, 2013

The meeting was called to order by the President, Pat McMillan at 3:00 PM. She welcomed all new delegates and all club presidents. The pledge of allegiance and invocation were led by Bill Morgan.

Board members in attendance were Pat and Lamar McMillan, president; Bill Morgan, treasurer; Julie Franciskato, recording secretary, Paul and Marilyn Scott, corresponding secretary.

Shirley White, chairman of the nominating committee introduced the new slate of officers for 2014/15. They are: President, Pat and Lamar McMillan; Vice President, Wayne and Debbie Miller; Recording Secretary, Margaret Cahan; Corresponding Secretary, Marilyn and Paul Scott; Treasurer, Betty Smith and Smitty Smith. Margaret, Debbie and Betty gave a brief introduction of themselves to the assembly.

The minutes of the last Delegates Meeting of April 14, 2013 were read by Julie Franciskato. A motion to accept the minutes as read was made by Anita Taylor and seconded by Linda Tester. There was no discussion and the motion passed.

The Treasurer's Report was read by Bill Morgan. (Attachment 1) There were several issues of concern from Tom Herscha and Val Newsom. Bill explained that he uses a Quicken program to track expenses and by default the errors were made. He can and will correct them and will send a new report out to everyone. A motion was made by Val Newsome and seconded by Ann Hadsell that the Treasurer's report be filed for audit. The motion passed.

Anita Taylor explained the distribution of profit funds from the State Convention. The bylaws state that the Federation receives $\frac{1}{4}$ of the profits, $\frac{1}{4}$ to Callers Association, $\frac{1}{4}$ the Cuers Association, and $\frac{1}{4}$ is split to the five Associations.

The report for the Fifth Saturday Dance was read by Pat McMillan deferring to Bill Morgan's financial report for expenses. (Attachment 2) Pat also explained about the high cost of the building rental stating that the last dance incurred charges of \$60 per hour. Although the dance is not for profit, Pat encourages all dancers that attend to make a donation so that expenses can be met. The next fifth Saturday dance is being planned and will be discussed later in the meeting.

The Class and Visitation report was read by Don Seay. (Attachment 3). Computer Liaison: No report.

Marilyn Scott read the report for the Fall Festival in the absence of Walt and Dianne Syphard. (Attachment 4) Linda Tester brought the display board for all to see. She will be putting together a basket for a raffle and will be asking each club to donate two tickets for a club dance. She also asks for all to bring in donations for the basket and participate in the sale of the tickets. Price of tickets will be 3 for \$5. The deadline for names in the directory is September 15th.

Bill Morgan read the Grapevine Report. We are in need of more subscriptions to keep the cost affordable.

Anita Taylor read the Florida Federation Report.

Pat Mc Millan presented an idea to create a coffee chairperson for Fifth Saturday dances in order to help with the many duties required of the Vice President. It was learned that in the past the Hosting Clubs performed many of these duties. We will return to using this method for future dances. The storage of the supplies remains a problem. An area 6ft by 6ft is needed. Anita Taylor volunteered to help the board if further clarification of duties is needed. Pauline Kilts made a motion which was seconded by Charlie Newsome to look into purchasing storage space. After discussion the motion did not pass.

NEFSARDA DELEGATES MEETING MINUTES –JULY 14, 2013

The Association is in need of a Publicity and Historian Chairperson. Delegates were asked to keep their clubs informed of what transpires at the Delegates meeting.

Joys and Concerns will now be chaired by Belinda Barker. The e mail address will remain the same. Please remember the HIPPA regulations when sending in notices of illnesses. It may be necessary to receive permission from the individual or their spouse before sharing their health issues.

Pat McMillan proposed we change the next fifth Saturday Dance to Sept. 7th instead of Aug. 31st due to Labor Day weekend. She suggested a spaghetti dinner where NEFSARDA would furnish the spaghetti, meat sauce, bread, paper products, drink and callers/cuers. It would be held at Richardson Community Center at 225 North East Coach Anders Lane, Lake City. The local clubs in that area, (Grand Squares and Vagabonds) as well as the Dixie Dancers, Silver Fox and Teddy Bears will host the dance. A donation of \$5 per person would be asked for the dance, the dinner would be free. The building charges a \$60.00 clean up fee and would be great for a dance. Callers may have to be changed to accommodate the new date. Val Newsome made a motion which was seconded by Paulette Kilts to accept the proposal. After discussion the motion passed. Belinda Barker will have to cancel previous plans made for the Fifth Saturday Dance on Aug. 31st.

Pat McMillan handed out Recruitment packages to the Club Delegates that were present. (Attachment 7) The packets were discussed. Clubs are encouraged to make their own business cards if they desire with their own phone number. The idea is to promote square dance lessons and have 100 students graduate next year. Be informed of the various clubs and where they dance and what night. Clubs are offering from two nights to one month of lessons free. The Dixie Dancers reported 7 new dancers taking classes now. Pat requested you ask for "freebies" from merchants you frequent that can be used as awards and prizes to dancers. She thanked everyone in advance for their help.

Val Newsome read the report for Dance Couple/Dancer of the Year.

Nominations are to be submitted by 9/15/2013.

Club Announcements followed. Our next Delegate meeting is scheduled for October 13, 2013 at the Quality Inn on Commonwealth, Jacksonville, FL at 3pm.

Pat Herscha made a motion, seconded by Ivan Hadsell to adjourn the meeting at 5pm.
