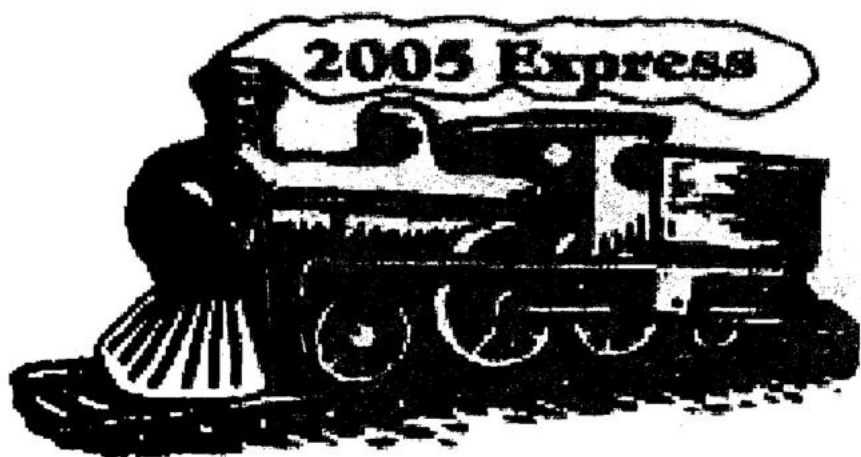

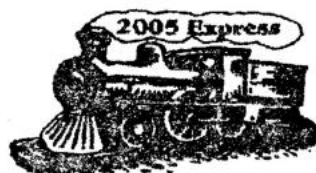

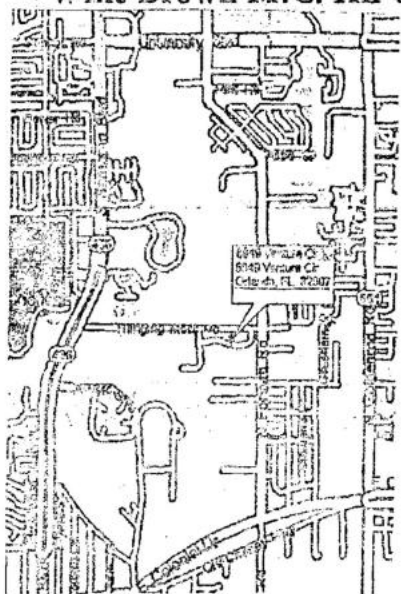

The National Folk Dance of America

H.R. 645, the bill designating "SQUARE DANCE" the National Folk Dance of America, also known as the "Promenade Act" was not successfully passed by the 108th Congress. The United Square Dancers of America, in a last effort, has contacted a U.S. Representative & a U.S. Senator from Arkansas along with a U.S. Representative from New Jersey to introduce the Square Dance Bill into the 109th Congress.

If the United Square Dancers of America are successful in this last attempt to re-introduce this bill naming "Square Dance", which includes contra, clogging, line dance, round dance, and the heritage dance as the National Folk Dance of America.

We must turn the heat up and get our Florida U.S. Representatives & U.S. Senators to co-sponsor this bill. To accomplish this we must get word to our U.S. Senators and Representatives that we want them to cosponsor this bill and get this passed in Congress.

I have volunteered to be your "letter coordinator" for Northwest Florida. In the upcoming year, I will need your help in contacting your families, your neighbors and even your enemies to support this bill. I need your support in getting letters, postcards, etc. signed and returned to me, so that I can mail them to your Congressional District's Representative and Senator.

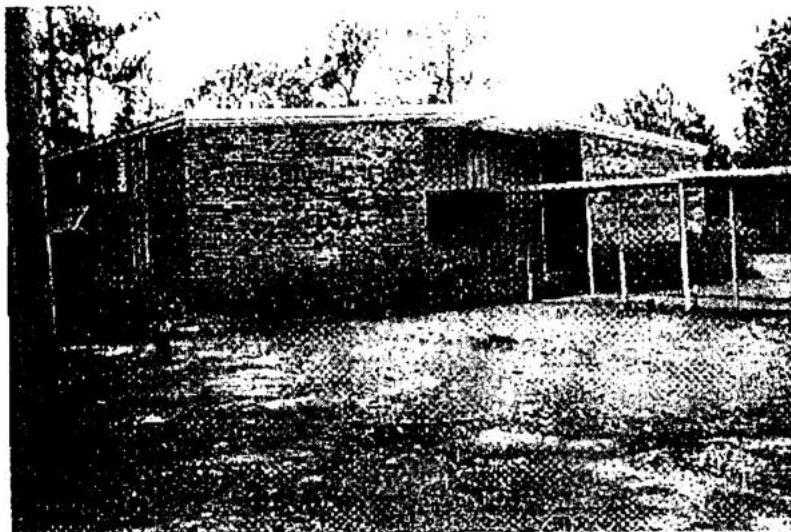

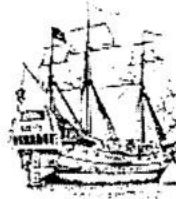
