Roll Call: Quorum present. Quorum consists of 25% of Board of Delegates (*Board of Delegates: Delegates from member area associations, member clubs, delegates-at-large, and the Executive Committee*). **Currently 16 / 25%= 4.**

Minutes: October 23, 2021 minutes approved with typo correction.

Financial Reports: See attached 2021 Roundup Statement and 4th Quarter Financial Report. 2021 Roundup: Income was \$1,557.63; Expenditures were \$2,078.26. Final Balance is -\$520.63. This was expected due to last minute changes and no ad sales. 4th Quarter Financial Report: due to bank takeover, account is now under PNC Bank. Starting Balance is \$11,138.77; Ending balance is \$10,726.98; savings are \$8,816.86. Insurance for all active clubs is paid. Reminders to use Additional Enrollment form to add new members throughout the year and USDA covers class members for up to 9 months.

Roundup 2022: Libby Penrod has submitted a status report. Ribbons have been ordered and received; if dancers want ribbons in advance, they can obtain from Libby. Ribbons will only be mailed to folks providing a SASE; otherwise they will be held at the door. Ribbons have been offered to the FFSD Officers free of charge (pickup at door). Chuck Davis has volunteered to be Emcee for the 2022 Roundup.

Public Relations: no report.

Panhandle Press: Publication was delayed to due to Laura. Membership Directory for NWFSRDA has been updated. Any non-renewals have been



purged. Reminder to folks to join the NWFSRDA to help support Square Dancing in our area!

Bylaws: Discussion held regarding the recently voted upon Bylaws' changes – these were approved at last quarterly meeting.

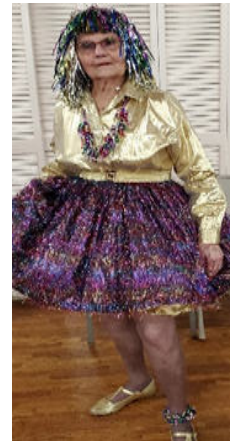


SEASIDE SQUARES
