LET'S SEE NOW

When recruiting prospective dancers for beginner's classes we promise fun, friendship and inexpensive recreation.

Are we living up to these commitments? Are we treating new dancers with great care and respect? If we fail, it will cost us the loss of these new dancers.

This we cannot afford as every club needs new members in order to survive.

The fun of square dancing should begin with the first lesson, continue through all lessons and right into clubs. Fun means understanding a movement, reacting correctly and automatically to that command, and dancing to the beat of the music.

Of course, the caller is responsible for teaching the basic lessons so thoroughly that new dancers feel comfortable dancing at THAT level. But, we too, have a responsibility.

What happens, after graduation, when these dancers join a club and the experienced members expect the caller to call at a level the club has built up and attained over a period of time? This is an area, in my opinion, that Callerlab's recommended establishment of plateau-level clubs would benefit both the new dancer and the experienced dancer.

But with or without plateau-levels, we must deliver on our promise to create a friendly atmosphere. This doesn't mean we are friendly only to those we brought to class, or just to the fast learners; it means every new dancer should feel welcome.

We must be tolerant of their inability to retain every movement. We must be patient and give them time to learn. Remember we were all beginners at one time.

By today's standards square dancing IS inexpensive. A long-sleeved shirt for the man and a full skirt or dress and low heel shoes for the lady is still not a great expense. Of course, costs are rising.

Hall rentals and callers fees have doubled and tripled during recent years which makes the price of dancing rise accordingly. But, compared to other activities, square dancing is inexpensive.

Our responsibility to the movement is to insure we deliver our promises.

### LEGACY

#### Leaders Gathered for Commitment & Yax

By now almost every square dancer has heard of Callerlab. But, what about Legacy? What is its purpose and how does it fit into the movement?

The purpose of Legacy is to pull all of the fragments of the activity together through communication and coordination, discuss problem areas and endeavor to solve these problems to insure a bright future for square dancing.

Legacy is an international organization comprised of leaders from the major segments of our activity. They are called "Trustees of the Legacy". They meet every two years, at their own expense, to communicate and coordinate the various phases of square dancing.

Trustees represent square dance record companies, suppliers and publications; caller and dancer associations; the National Convention, etc.

During their meeting in Memphis, Tn. earlier this year, the emphasis was on problem solving. The following is passed along to you.

Legacy Trustees agreed that adherence to good ethics is essential.

Visitation among clubs should be encouraged. But, members of one club should NOT recruit members from another same level club.

The laxity by some dancers and callers to wear proper square dance attire was a topic of discussion.

New dancers should be encouraged early in the teaching stage to wear proper attire. They set the responsibility squarely on the shoulders of leaders and callers to set a good example.

## SQUARE DANCE TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL TEACHERS

Bob Ruff, a professional educator and caller-teacher with 30 years experience, has joined forces with the Nebraska State Department of Education and the Nebraska Square and Round Dance Asn. to establish a state-wide square dance training program for school teachers, callers and youth leaders.

Participating teachers will learn basic skills and teaching techniques of square dancing, get ideas on how to start this program at various grade levels and ideas on using contemporary music and dances. Teachers will also learn how to use a variety of material to maintain enthusiasm and will practice creating dances so they can do their own calling.
