CALLERLAB would like to offer the following advice on the proper usage of quarterly selections.

1. QS calls are not a mandatory part of any program. Dancers are not to be held accountable for selections past or present.
2. QS calls should be verbally mentioned and/or physically workshopped prior to being called the first time at an open dance. QS calls are to be used at the caller's discretion.
3. Conventions and festivals shall be encouraged to delete quarterly selections from all halls designated. For example, the Mainstream Hall should read MS, not MS + QS or MSQS.

### USDA MID-YEAR MEETING

The USDA has scheduled its 1987-1988 Mid Year Executive Board Meeting for January 22 and 23, 1988 in Atlanta, GA. These annual two day meetings and work sessions are open to any and all interested dancers, leaders, or other individuals with a desire to contribute to the further development and growth of this National Dancer organization.

A full agenda is planned. Among the items to be discussed will be the review of membership applications, reports on the progress of the 1988 Dancer Insurance Program and the Handicapable Dancer Program.

Working sessions will be held to analyze possible revisions to the USDA By-Laws and Standing Rules for presentation at the Annual Meeting to be held in June concurrently with the Annual National Square Convention in Anaheim, CA.

Another area in which the USDA is extremely active is the promotion of Square Dancing as the National Dance. Efforts are proceeding with the gathering of Congressional Co-Sponsors for this legislation within the 100th Congress.

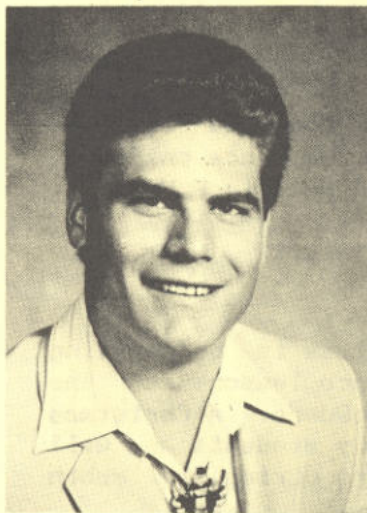

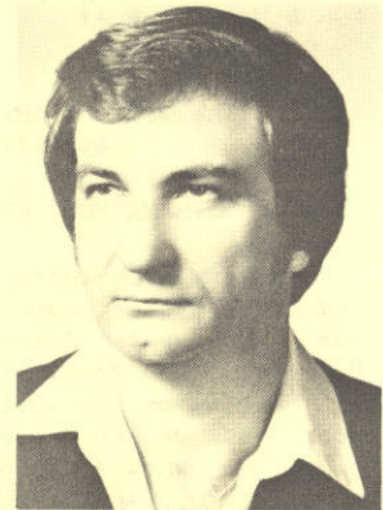

Almost 1,000 LEGACY promotional kits have been distributed world-wide, it was announced today by Stan and Cathie Burdick, LEGACY Square Dance Month chairmen.

The purpose of the kits, subsidized by LEGACY and available for only \$1.00 postage and handling charge, was to make available 22 pages (including a poster) to those responsible for recruitment and promotion of fall classes. It is hoped that their use will help to increase the numbers in square dance classes, the Burdicks said.

The theme of Square Dance Month (September) this year was "Program for Fun," and was tied in with the design of a computer. Some of the promotional copy made available to the key promoters read as follows:

"Are you in the right 'mood,' and is all your equipment, (resources, plans) in the proper 'mode' for the big push to 'program for fun?' Your screen should be green for 'go.' Your 'hard drive' for new recruits should be well established and your 'readout' should show plenty of recruits by now. We really need to 'double the dancers' this fall, and your efforts are essential.

"Don't forget to really 'Program for Fun' in those first few lessons to keep 'em wanting more. Remember the LEGACY survey that told us convincingly: 'The fun is gone—bring it back.' Make every class a friendly, social event as well as a learning experience. Keep those portals open for three consecutive sessions (Coast a bit with the same dozen or 15 basics.) to build those numbers a bit. ('Beginners beget beginners,' as they say.) The units are on. All systems are 'go.' Now it's up to you to 'Program for Fun.' "



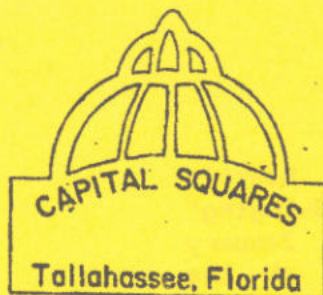
