## CLUB NEWS - BAYOU SHUFFLERS & SANDPI- PERS

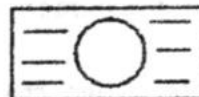

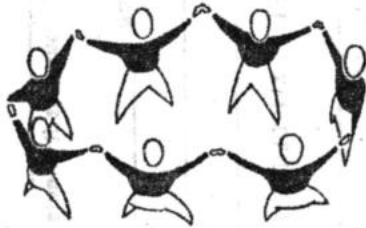
All proceeds from the dance, flea market, and donations from clubs will go to the 1997 National Convention Bid effort. Will you help to bring the National Convention to Florida?
