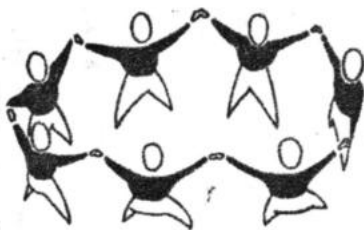

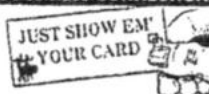

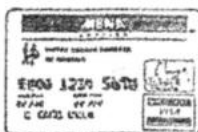

HISTORY OF THE ASSOCIATION

This is the first in a series of articles covering the history of the Northwest Florida Square & Round Dance Association. The purpose of these articles is to record the events which resulted in the association that we have today. It is hoped that current members will find our history informative and interesting.

Dateline 1974

The need for an association was recognized by several Northwest Florida dancers in June 1974 while attending the National Convention in San Antonio, Texas. The Florida "Showcase of Ideas" display depicted the total absence of Square Dancing in NW Florida, which, of course, was simply not true. The problem was that we were organized by club and/or local councils and were autonomous without a central organization to represent us at State and National levels.

After some preliminary investigation including compilation of the first directory of NW Florida clubs, a meeting was held on October 12, 1974, in Ft. Walton Beach at the home of Joe and Doris Vaccari to discuss the feasibility of forming an association. In attendance were representatives from Pensacola, Panama City, Crestview and Ft. Walton Beach. It was apparent to the group that many benefits could accrue from an association. The group decided to call an organizational meeting for late November and invite representatives from all clubs and councils in NW Florida. A committee was formed consisting of Chester and Bettye Price, Marvin and Olena Taylor, George and Mary Bowie, and Joe and Doris Vaccari to draft a constitution and by-laws.

The organizational meeting was held on November 24, 1974, at Bayside Recreational Center, Panama City, Florida--hosted by George and Mary Bowie. Thirty-five people attended representing all known clubs and councils except one. The constitution/by-laws were adopted and officers elected.

The organizational meeting set the stage for the association to start work to serve the clubs and to further the growth of the activity. Stay tuned. The next article will detail the events of 1975-- a most significant year in our history.

Pick Up Two and Make It Six Hands 'Round

(Number 1 man breaks, takes the hand of Number 3 lady while her partner, Number 3 man, takes the hand of Number 2 lady and circles six.)

Pick Up Two and Make It Eight Hands 'Round

There'll Be a Hot Time in the Old Town Tonight

(Number 1 man breaks circle as he comes around and picks up lady Number 4. Her partner joins hands with lady Number 3 and circle eight hands to the left.)

Allemande Left with the Lady on Your Left

Allemande Right with the Lady on Your Right

(Pass your partner by the right shoulder (ladies going on the outside, men on the inside of the circle) going to the original right hand lady and do a right allemande)

Allemande Left with the Lady on Your Left

(Pass your partner by the left shoulder (men on the inside of the circle again) going to your original corner with your left hand and do a regular left allemande.)

And a Grand Right and Left All Around, My Baby

Meet Your Honey and Do a Do-Sa-Do

Take That Baby in Your Arms, 'Round and Around you Go

(Regular waist swing.)

Now Promenade Around With the Sweetest Girl in Town

There'll Be a Hot Time in the Old Town Tonight

(Turn your partner under your arm after the swing and promenade her back to your original home spot, turn her under your arm, balance away and face the center of the square.)

(Repeat this three more times to get each couple as the active unit.)

Carpet to be Covered with Wood

It's a big request: To cover all carpeted dance areas with a material that would support thousands of dancers with the utmost in comfort and durability. And it will be accomplished, thanks to the special purchase of 65,000 square feet of high quality hardboard from Dee Forest Products of Oregon.

The dance floors at the 43rd National Square Dance Convention in Portland will include cement, hardwood and the hardboard paneling. Similar flooring has already been used successfully at major dances in the Portland area.

Installation of the flooring will be done by Greyhound Exposition Services of Portland. After the convention, the flooring can be purchased by individuals or organizations at a reduced rate. Contact General Chairmen Don and Shirley White: P.O. Box 710, Dallas, OR 97338-0710.

First Aid Services Available

The 43rd National Square Dance Convention in Portland will have First Aid stations in the Oregon Convention Center and the Portland Coliseum for emergency care. If you need assistance, contact any convention committee person and they will call for First Aid assistance. There is a hospital very close by and the Portland 9-1-1 system provides quick response in case of a major emergency.

However, when you pack your bags, be sure to include a few band-aids and a bottle of aspirin to take care of a blister or a headache. That's a suggestion from Lee and Becky Roberts, Vice-Chairmen of Auxiliary Services, in charge of First Aid. These are common ailments at conventions and having such items on hand will save a walk to a First Aid station and keep it free to handle true emergencies.

Pendulum Clock: A Convention Center Crowd-Pleaser

One of the most-asked-about pieces of art in the Oregon Convention Center is not only a work of art; it's a working pendulum "clock" that charts the rotation of the earth. Named Principia, the pendulum's hypnotic motion is a favorite with young and old alike.

Principia consists of a 750-pound hollow brass ball suspended 95 feet above the floor. The ball swings back and forth in arcing motions, influenced by the Earth's rotation. As it swings, it flips up pairs of golden rods, constructed of fishing pole material, which chart the earth's motion by corresponding with the fanciful "map" on the terrazzo floor below. Look for this sculpture at the northwest end of the lower hallway in Concourse A at Oregon Convention Center.
