Doren McBroom, Chairman of the Plus Quarterly Selection Committee, announces that **FOLLOW THRU**, has been selected as the Plus Quarterly Selection for the period November 1, 1994 to March 1, 1995.

*Quarterly Selections are provided as optional material for those callers and/or clubs that wish to include a workshop in their dance programs. They are not a part of the Plus Program. No dancer should be required to know the Quarterly Selections to attend an open Plus dance. If a Quarterly Selection is used, the caller should walk it through or workshop it first.*

**FOLLOW THRU**  
by Dewey Berry - 1969

STARTING FORMATION: Box Circulate.

NOTE: Equals the 1st half of a Scoot Back.

DEFINITION: In facing dancers Extend and Single Hinge while the out facing dancers do 1/2 of a Box Circulate.

ENDING FORMATION: Two Faced Line

DANCE EXAMPLE: Heads Square Thru, Touch 1/4, Split Circulate, **FOLLOW THRU**, Bend the Line, Slide Thru, Left Allemande.

Heads Square Thru, Swing Thru, Men Run, 1/2 Tag, **FOLLOW THRU**, Wheel and Deal, Pass Thru, Right and Left Grand.

SINGING CALL EXAMPLE: Heads Promenade 1/2, Square Thru, Touch 1/4, **FOLLOW THRU**, Couples Circulate, 1/2 Tag, **FOLLOW THRU**, Ferris Wheel, Pass Thru, Swing, Promenade.

TIMING: 4 beats

# NORTHWEST FLORIDA SQUARE AND ROUND DANCE ASSOCIATION

## HISTORY OF THE ASSOCIATION

This is the fifth in a series of articles covering the history of the Northwest Florida Square & Round Dance Association. The purpose of these articles is to record the events which resulted in the Association that we have today.

Dateline 1978

The Association continued to grow under the able leadership of its President, Marvin & Olena Taylor. Meetings in 1978 were held in Panama City, Ft. Walton Beach, Tallahassee and Chipley. Some of the significant events of 1978 were:

1. The insurance program expanded as more clubs became aware of its benefits.
2. The first club Directory which included dance level designations was published in the Panhandle Press. Marty Lackey was editor, and six (6) issues a year were being published. Many educational articles appeared. News from eleven (11) clubs appeared in the March issue, Christmas ads filled the December issue. The newsletter was almost self-sustaining.
3. Northwest Florida license plate dance tags were made available for \$2.50 each. They included the club name or city. Chairman of this fund raising was John Lackey.
4. Two (2) roundups were held--the Spring Roundup in Pasarda Hall in Ft. Walton Beach on March 25 with Darryl McMillan and Chuck Sample, and the Fall Roundup in Panama City, November 3-4, with Dick Barker, Jerry Helt and Kent Bartlett. Location was the Ranch House.
5. Many Northwest dancers attended the Silver Anniversary State Convention in Orlando. Theme was "Celebrate in '78."
6. Planning for hosting the 1981 State Convention began. Marvin & Olena Taylor were named chairman for our first State Convention. A special meeting was held at the Hardy House Restaurant, Chipley, to confirm our intent and obtain support from the NW Callers Association. Both organizations decided the NW would host the 1981 Convention.
7. Some quarterly movements for 1978 were: Trade the Wave, Stroll and Cycle, Ping Pong Circulate. Foley Wood was President of the NW Callers Association.
8. Financial status of the association in 1978:

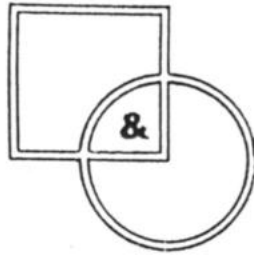

### SEWING SOUTHERN STYLE

Sewing Southern Style is the theme chosen for the Sew and Save Program for the 44th National Square Dance Convention. The program is designed to interest both the sewer and non-sewer. As the visitor enters the most spacious facilities, not only will they be greeted by the smiling faces of the Alabama host and hostesses of Sew and Save, but also they will receive a most warm welcome from the Southern veranda awaiting them inside the reception area. Visitors should virtually feel the southern breezes and hear a "Howdy y'all" greeting in the air.

Once inside, on-going demonstrations from the booths will be taking place on numerous subjects. Sewing-machine-company representatives will be anxious to show their machines, from the plain stitcher to the most sophisticated computer machines and sergers. Quilt makers will be on hand with an actual quilt set up in the frame and will demonstrate quilting techniques.

Seminars on various subjects should prove interesting to both sewer and non-sewer. Sewing short-cuts, prairie skirts, western-wear coordination and accessorizing, many uses of the serger--these are just a few of the topics of our seminars. There will be something for everyone at Sew and Save, including an area for the tired partners to rest while the girls (or guys) enjoy the many events going on at Sew and Save.

### TAKE ME TO DREAMLAND

No beans. No slaw. No potato salad. Don't ask. And who needs the frou-frou fixings when you have some of the best ribs this side of, well, Tuscaloosa.

Yes, after years of driving 50 miles west to the city of the Crimson Tide to satisfy a rib need, Birmingham folks at last have their own Dreamland. The Southside restaurant is owned and operated by Jeannette Bishop Hall, daughter of the original Dreamland owners "Big John" and Lillie Bishop.

Birmingham's Dreamland is larger than the original--115 seats here compared to 49 there--but the ribs are just the same slow-cooked, succulent, saucy hunks of hog heaven.

The cafe serves only ribs (slabs, cut slabs and singles), white bread, beer and soft drinks. Diehard Dreamland fans like it that way.

Located in one of Birmingham's oldest neighborhoods, Dreamland is within walking distance of the University of Alabama at Birmingham. The wait in line can be as long as an hour, but customers are learning to arrive at other-than-peak times.

Dreamland is on 15th Street and 14th Avenue South and is open from 10 a.m. until 20 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and until midnight on Friday and Saturday.
