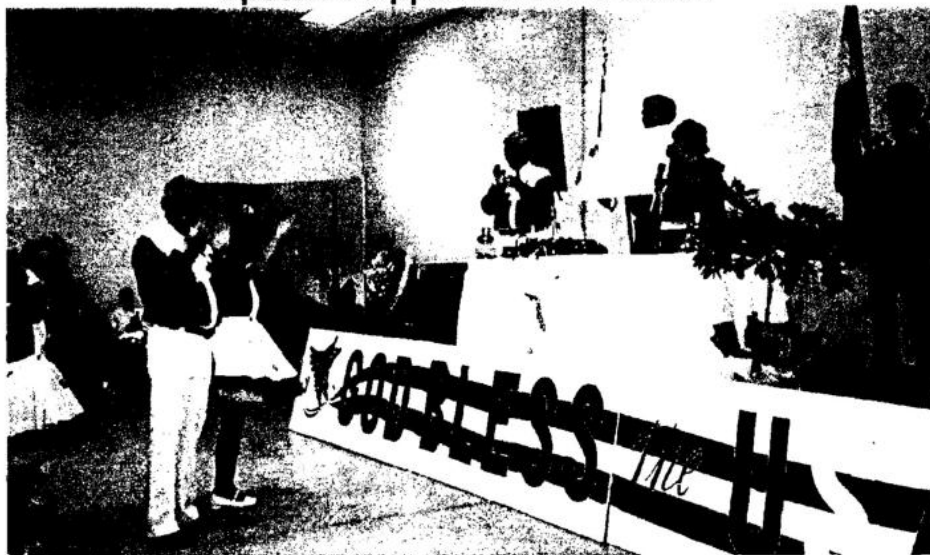
### **PROMENADE ACT**

Dancers throughout the state of Florida are being encouraged to contact their State Representatives asking them to Co-Sponsor H.R. 645, also known as the "Promenade Act". The "Promenade Act" will permanently designate the Square Dance as the National Folk Dance of the USA. NWFSRDA's three Congressional Districts are: District 1 Jeff Miller, District 2 Allen Boyd, District 4 Ander Crenshaw.

If you have internet access, you can go to the USDA home page at [www.usda.org](http://www.usda.org) and click on the Folk Dance banner to obtain more information on this bill. Telephone calls to your Representative are also effective.

Passage of the "Promenade Act" bill could bring about a resurgence in Square Dancing. We can make this happen with all of your help.

The Florida Association of Single Square & Round Dancers (FASSRD) is a non-profit organization established [25 years ago] to promote and stimulate fellowship and interest in square and round dancing among unmarried adults of all ages throughout Florida.

The officers for 2003-2004 are President: Penny Green (West Coast Association); Vice President: Nita Flanagan (Central Association); Secretary: Mary Lou Pelz (Northeast Association); and Treasurer (Mr.) Carroll Pomplin (Central Association). The area reps are Shirley White (Northeast Association), Bill Shellman (West Coast Association), Lorrie Bernal (Central Association) and Millie Griffin (Southeast Association).

We host an annual Single Rama at the historic Kenilworth Lodge in Sebring, FL in October. The next one will be October 8 & 9, 2004 with Joe Fioretti of Homosassa, FL, and Whit Brown of Orlando calling and Jimmy and Carol Griffin of St. Pete cueing. We also have a vendor for the weekend. We have dances and workshops as well as two after parties with entertainment provided by AJJ Entertainment from Marietta, GA.

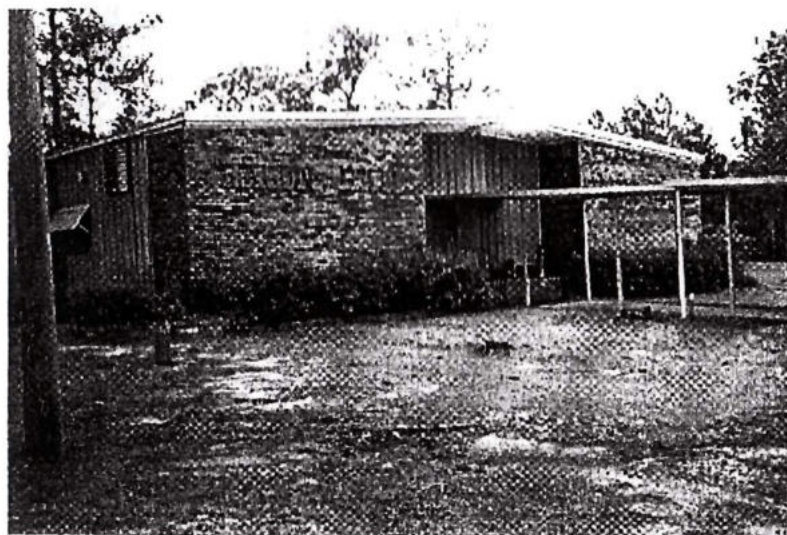

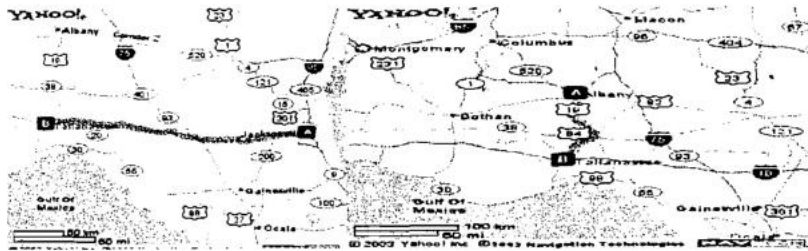

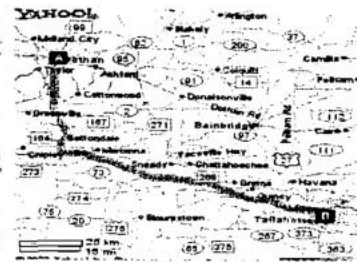
