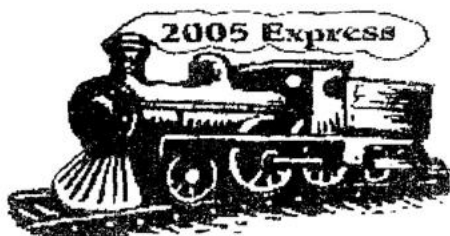
### **PASARDA Hall - Ft. Walton Beach, FL**

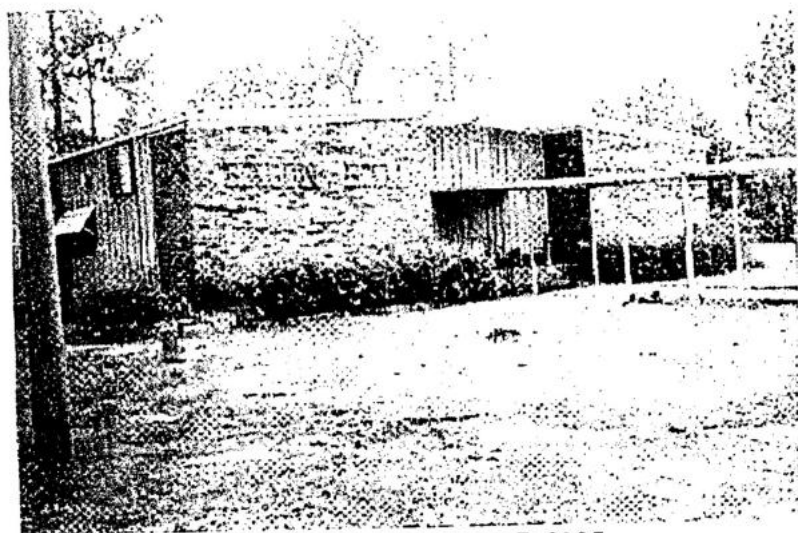

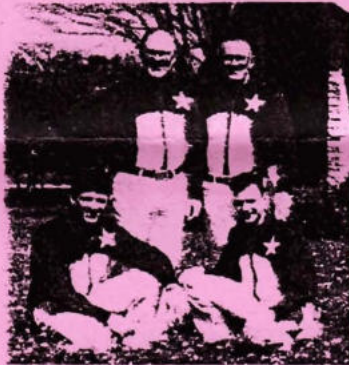
