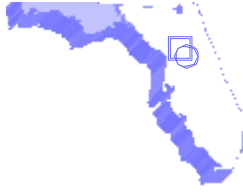

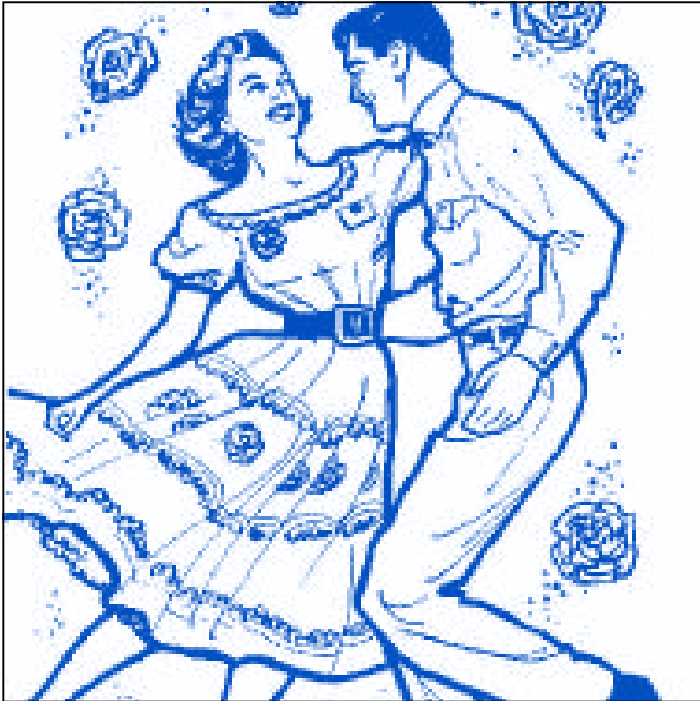

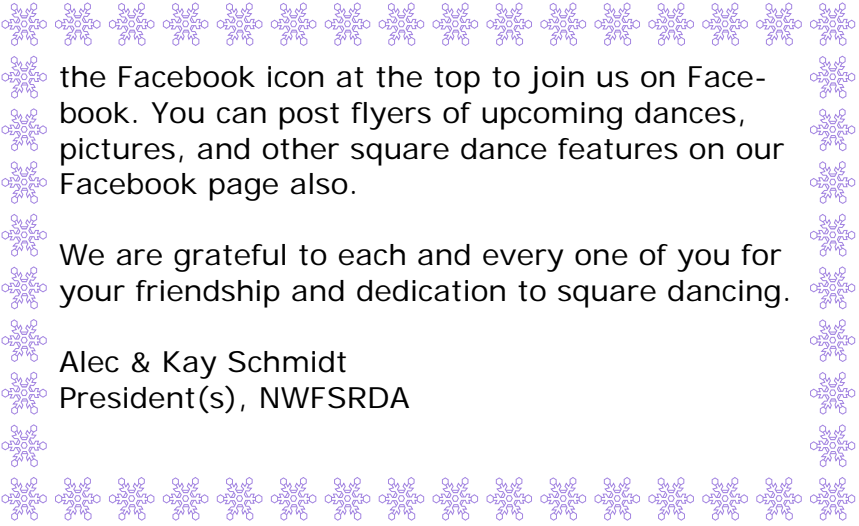

We would like to encourage our NWF dancers to support each other's clubs. We all know "the more the merrier," so when you can, try to visit other NWF clubs for their dances.

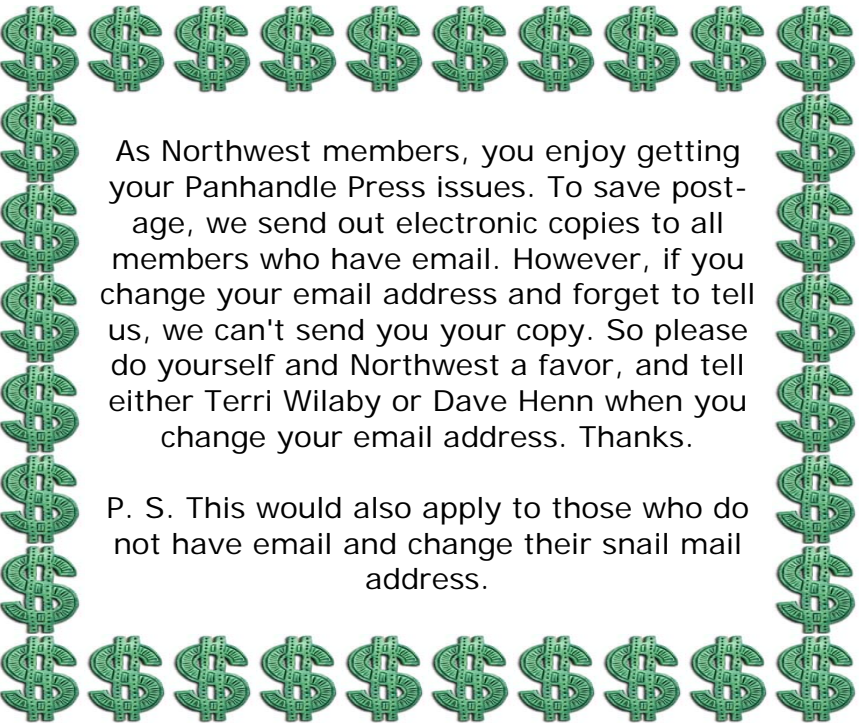

Ann Merriwether has been square dancing since the late 1970's. She learned to square dance with caller Foley Wood and also learned to clog around the same time. As she became more proficient she joined the square dancers and cloggers in performing exhibitions to introduce others to Modern Western Dance and traveled to many dances around the Southeast.

In 2007, after several years' hiatus from dancing, she took a refresher class from Berlon Graham and was once again hooked. She joined Agape Squares in Neville and danced with Bill Van Hoesen's club in Fort Walton Beach. She single handedly took on the task of 'advertising and "outreach" director' for the Fort Walton Beach Dancing Dolphins and took every opportunity to encourage others to dance as much as they could in all of the area's clubs and at square dance events throughout the South. Every week she could be found spending many hours scouring the internet for places to dance, printing calendars and flyers for the dancers, and putting all of our local club dances on the internet wherever she could find a place to advertise them. She even helped people find a place to dance when they were traveling out of town!

Ann also aided the callers whenever and however she could.
