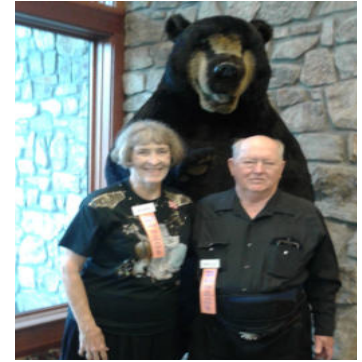

Meeting – October 23, 2021 @ 11:10 AM Grand Square Hall, Panama City, FL**

Call to Order & Invocation



Welcome

Roll Call: Quorum present. Quorum consists of 25% of Board of Delegates (*Board of Delegates: Delegates from member area associations, member clubs, delegates-at-large, and the Executive Committee*). Currently 12 / 25%= 3.

Minutes: July 11 minutes approved.

Financial Reports: See attached Financial Report. Note: The Callers Association has dissolved and has donated funds of \$2,566.15 to NWFSRDA to be used for educational purposes. Ending balance is \$11,063.77; savings are \$8,816.57. there is a change to the individual insurance cost – moving from \$4.85 to \$5.00. Insurance is due to Alec by December 15. Reminder that NWF membership covers insurance requirements. Renewal forms for 2022 insurance are available. The club policy has a \$45.00 minimum.

Roundup 2021-the Roundup this year will not break even. We are not doing a program with ads. This dance is not intended to be a fundraiser, it should be non-profit. Many have assisted with hosting this event including providing food.

Roundup 2022 – see report. Caller and Cuer have been booked as well as the venue – Tallahassee Senior Center for July 29-30, 2022. Projected cost to date is \$3,277.00.

Public Relations: no report. Due to lack of activity, Jim Walters is stepping down.

Panhandle Press: note-this is published each quarter and the deadlines are in the Press.

Bylaws: DeeCee Haslett, Chairperson, has the following recommendations:

- No change is needed in the Bylaws for holding Board meetings virtually.
- Waive four-year limit on holding office for current office holders. Moved and approved.

1. ARTICLE X, Section 4, E. - Revise to “prepare a written report of Northwest Association finances, including a quarterly report of income, expenses and net gain/loss specifically attributable to the operation of the Newsletter Committee, for each quarterly meeting and at the close of his/her term of office.”
2. ARTICLE XI, Section 4, 3rd sentence – Revise to “The Newsletter Committee shall ensure payment has been received by the Treasurer for submitted ads and flyers before publication.”
3. ARTICLE XI, Section 4, 4th sentence through end of paragraph – Delete.
4. ARTICLE XI, Section 4, after 3rd sentence – Add - The Panhandle Press shall be provided electronically, or via mail, to each NWFSRDA individual member, NWFSRDA club and NWFSRDA area association. As a courtesy, an electronic copy may be provided to other active Florida square and round dance associations, the Florida Federation of Square Dancers, and the United Square Dancers Association (USDA).

Florida Federation State Convention on March 18-19, 2022 in Daytona Beach. We do have a group going, so if you are interested just let us know.

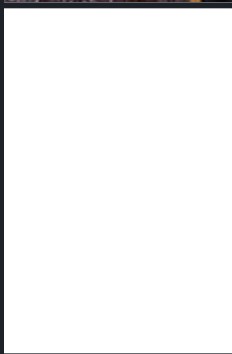
