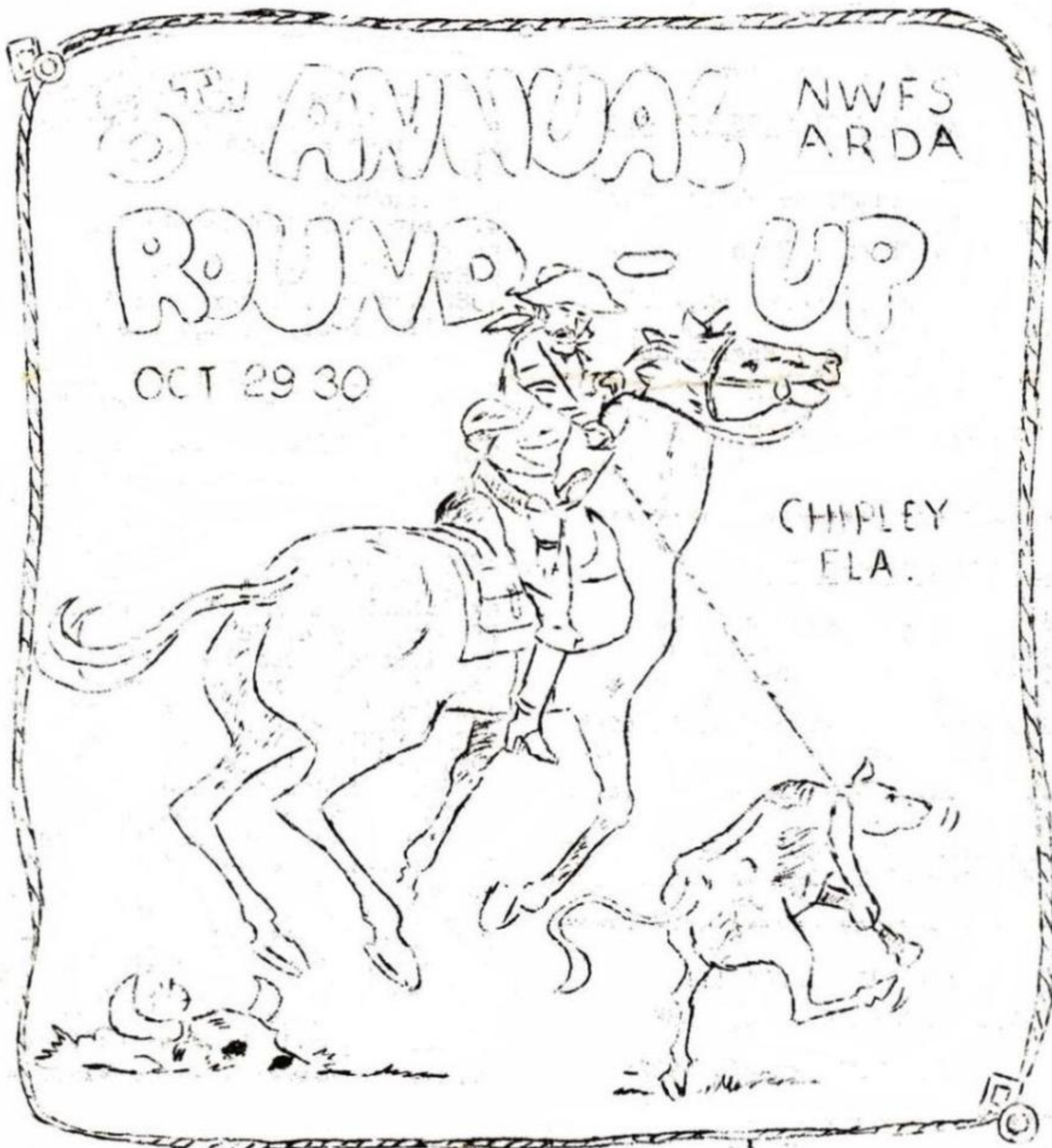

WHERE DO WE STAND NOW????

May 11, 1982-The House passed SJR 59 (The Senate version of HJR 151) with an amendment, offered by Congressman Robert Garcia, N.Y. Chairman of The Subcommittee on Census & Population. The Amendment limits the Resolution to 1982 & 1983. The amended Resolution was approved by the Senate May 19, 1982.

Senator Byrd's Office informed us; President Reagan signed the Resolution into an Act, June 1, 1982.

The following is reprinted from the May 1982 issue of TIPS, the Birmingham Square Dance Assoc. Newsletter. by John Paul Bresnan  
.....

The subject of non-square dancing children at dances is one that usually will bring some discussion. I feel that I can give an opinion because as a parent and with some experience of what I have seen at dances. I think that all will agree that children running in and out of squares at a dance could be dangerous not only to themselves but to dancers, whose line of thought is centered on dancing and not watching out for small children. I realize that it is not always possible to find baby-sitters and we must bring children with us, but do we find time to see that they have something to do or just turn them loose while we enjoy ourselves? Children will find something to do and sometimes that infringes on others and that can be a problem.

Being responsible for halls on several occasions I know first hand some things that can happen and they are: 1. Fill the commode with toilet paper. 2. Run toys accross the floor during dances. 3. Abuse the telephone. 4. Laughing and talking so loud that dancers cannot hear. 5. Abuse elevators. These are the types of things that infringe on others.

I am sure you have your own thoughts on this subject and I won't drag out all of mine but I would like to make some suggestions about non-dancing children at dances: 1. Have something for them to do such as games. 2. Make sure they are served refreshments (no one likes to eat after children have fingered the food). 3. Stay after the dance and help cleanup, especially if your child has been involved. No one likes to clean up after others. At the end of the dance don't take children and leave. 4. Caution them on telephone priveleges. Most halls must be left like we find them and we can't afford to be run out of halls. They are hard to find.
