Ask your Congressmen to be Cosponsors of H.R. 2067 the Bill to have the Square Dance permanently designated the American Folk Dance.

Generally, members of Congress will respond only to the residents of their Congressional Districts. They do want to learn how their Constituents feel about public policy issues. They will usually respond well to carefully written and concerned letters.

Keep your letter reasonably brief and state the topic clearly in the first paragraph. Make sure you refer to the title of the Bill and the number assigned. Give good reasons and be positive in your approach. Make the letter your own rather than a form letter. Be courteous, do not beg or threaten a member of Congress. Appeal to the lawmaker on the merits of your issue.

We can get more than the required 218 Cosponsors before September 17, 1987, the 200th Anniversary of our Constitution. When your Congressman agrees to Cosponsor, please notify the National Folk Dance Committee at P.O. Box 840556, Pembroke Pines, FL 33084 and the Editor of this Newsletter.

Write your Congressmen now! Let's petition them to Cosponsor H.R. 2067 and make the "Square Dance" the official permanent Folk Dance of the United States. Address your letters to the appropriate Representative or Senator as follows:
