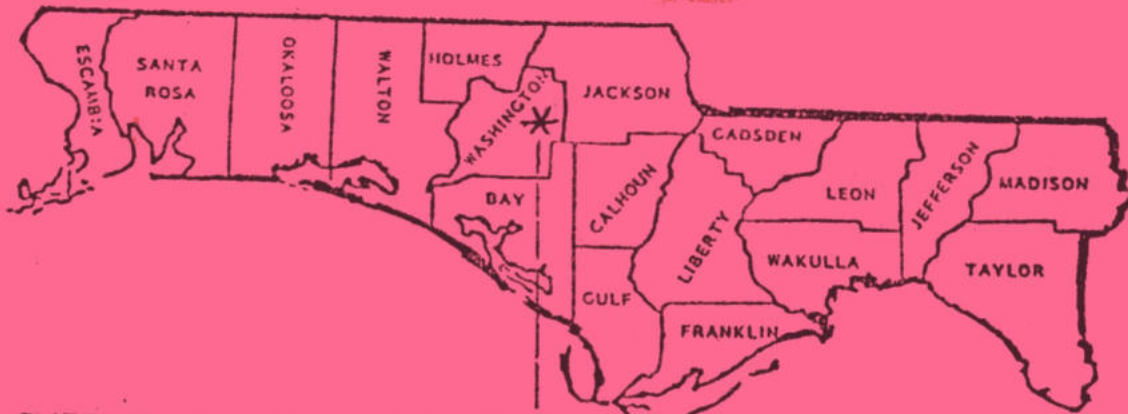

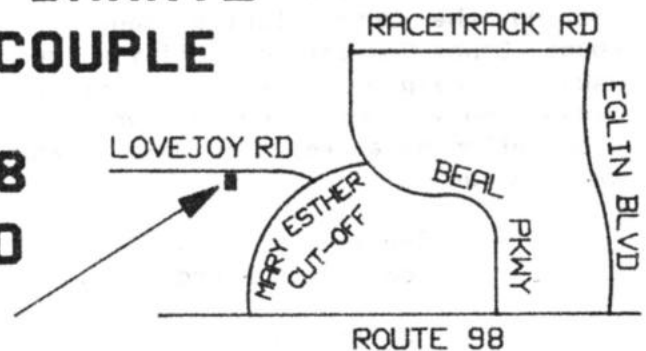

### CALLERLAB QUARTERLY SELECTION

Tom Sellner, Chairman of the Plus Quarterly Selection Committee, is pleased to announce the selection of the PQS figure for the quarter beginning August 1, 1990. The figure is STAR TRACK, authored by Lee Hailey, Glendale, Arizona.

Starting formation: Static Square  
The Action: The head couples Star Thru, All Double Pass Thru, and start a Track II. As soon as you meet your original partner, Star Thru. At this point you have completed 1/4 of the action and are in a static square with the side couples across the set. Repeat the same action with the side couples starting the action. Repeat with the heads starting; then the sides and you have completed the 64 beat figure.

Ending formation: Static Square  
Timing: 64 beats (Twice for the heads and twice for the sides. Can be used as individual 16 beat portions.)

### DANCE-A-ROUND R/D CLUB;Panama City,FL

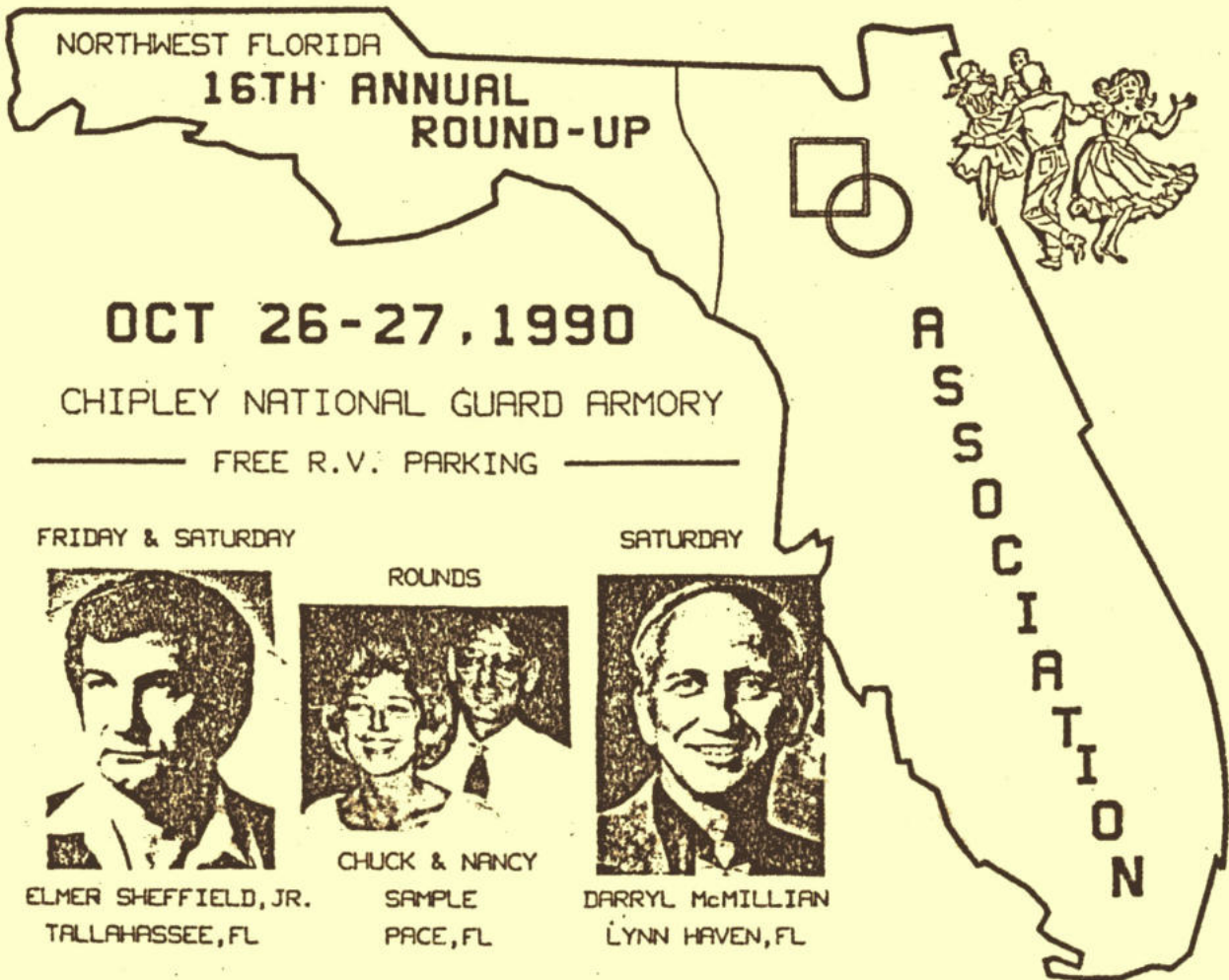
Things are a little quiet now that our Snowbirds have flown North. We had to suspend our Carousel Club on Sundays until September, but continue to have our regular Monday night dances.

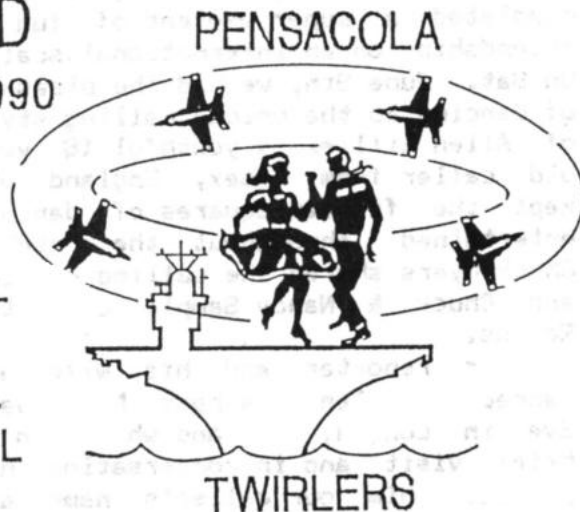

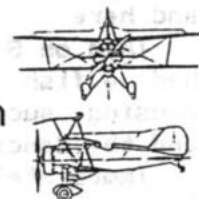

## ROUNDALAB'S 14TH ANNUAL CONVENTION

263 Round Dance Teachers, representing 137 teaching units, from 37 states in the United States, two Canadian Provinces, the Netherlands, New Zealand, and West Germany attended the 14th Annual Convention of ROUNDALAB, the International Association of Round Dance Teachers, Inc., held at the OMNI Hotel in Memphis, TN last June.

Also in attendance were Herb Egender and Bill Higgins representing CALLERLAB; Walt & Louise Cole from CONTRALAB; Stan & Cathie Burdick, Chairman of LEGACY; Ernie & Barbara Stone from the National Executive Committee of the NSDC; Jim & Elaine Snowden from the URDC; and Frank & Nan Habersberger, Presidents of the United Square Dancers of America.

At this 14th Convention the membership intituted a Teacher Training & Preparation Program that includes developing a ROUNDALAB approved curriculum for teacher training schools and clinics. Committees area also working on preparing guidelines for Instuctor Preparation Assistance and developing a testing program for teachers who desire to be instructors or teachers. Four tuition scholarships were awarded to members planning to attend Round Dance Teacher Schools.

There was a strong feeling of cooperation and comraderie among the attendees as they continued the work of the Round Dance Standardization, Teaching Progression, and Cueing Guidelines Committees.

Elected to the Board of Directors were Joe & Jo Carnevale (TX), Ralph & Joan Collipi (NH), Carmen & Mildred Smarrelli (MD), and Dale & Jo Zumwalt (MA).

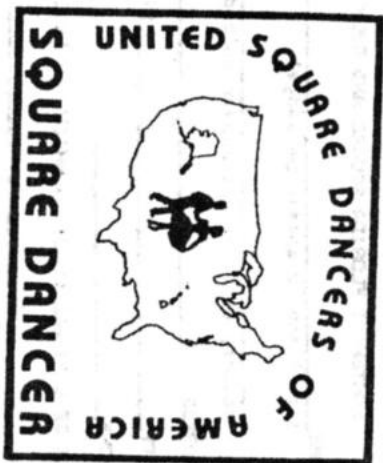

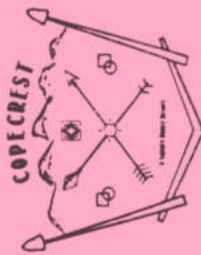

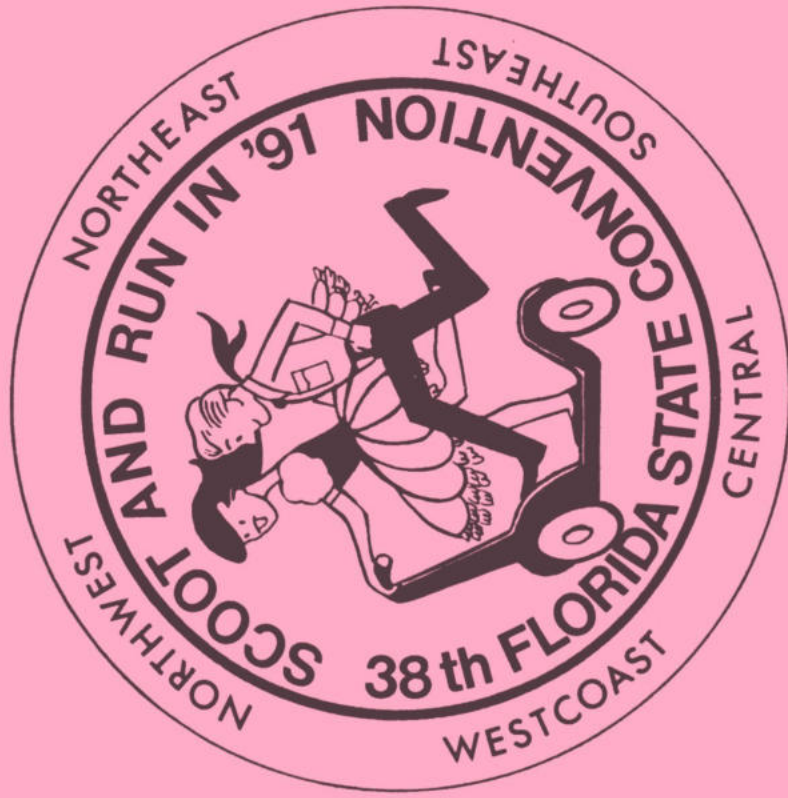
