## NATIONAL SQUARE DANCE CONVENTION, THE ORGANIZATION

The National Square Dance Convention (NSDC) is sponsored and guided by the National Executive Committee (NEC), an organization composed of all General Chairmen of Past National Conventions.

This Committee awards Conventions to Square Dance Organizations (which have been carefully investigated), who provide host cities that are thoroughly inspected by the NEC.

Conventions are awarded four years in advance following public presentations open to all square dancers at 9 a.m. on Friday mornings of convention week. Each hosting organization takes full responsibility for the financial success of its convention for which it receives all income with the exception of a small per person fee retained by the NEC.

NEC members are assigned to specific areas of the United States to investigate future convention sites. An advisor and an assistant advisor are appointed for each convention and they meet with hosting organizations at least every two months.

NEC members and their wives receive their air fare coach fares when attending the Pre-Convention meetings and on advisory visits, but pay all their own expenses including registration fees at convention time.

When conventions are awarded, sponsoring organizations must present a plan for the use of any surplus funds for the benefit of square dancing in their area.

The NEC has prepared a very complete set of guidelines for the use of the hosting organization and several copies are provided to all future conventions. In addition to the guidelines, two other publications have been provided: "Procedures For Submitting a Bid" and "Statement of Policies for Conducting a Convention".

A tremendous responsibility rests on the shoulders of the NEC members to assure an acceptable National Convention. A NSDC is sponsored, planned and conducted by volunteers. An amazing feat and truly the "World's Greatest Square Dance Event"

## NORTHWEST ASSOCIATION SUPPORTS BID EFFORT

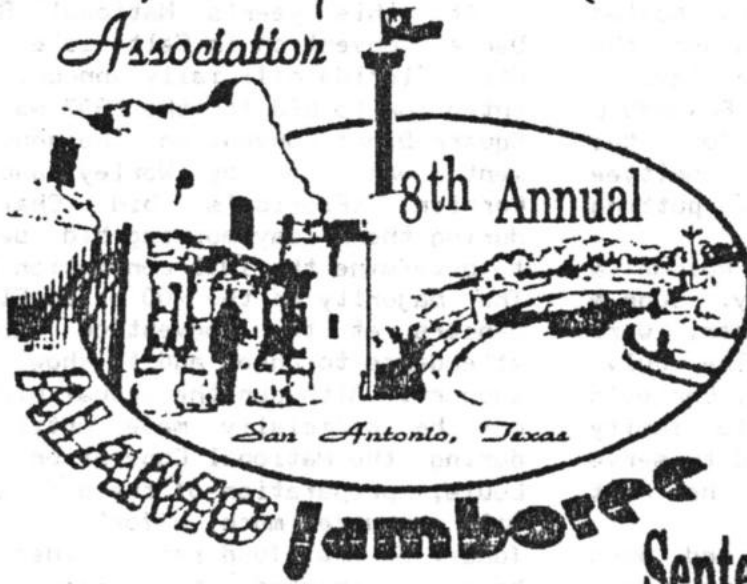
