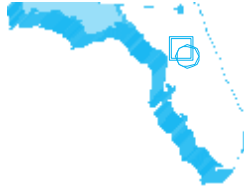

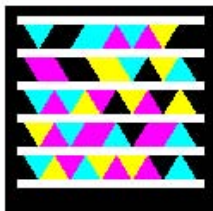
60th Florida State Square & Round Dance Convention

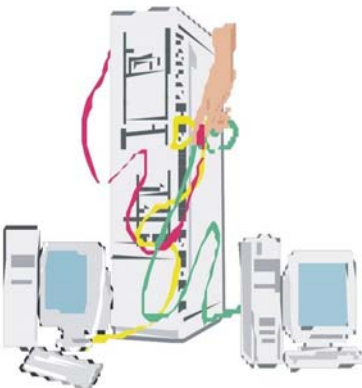

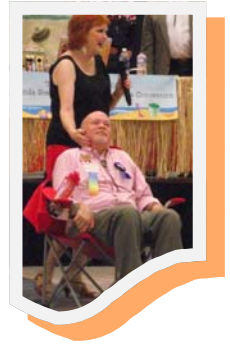
We will continue to work on the fox-trot across the summer, until we begin swing (a.k.a jive) in September.
