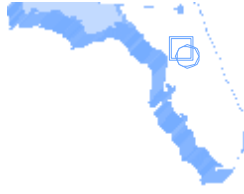

Time sure does fly. Even though Tim and I have been busy the last few weeks, I noticed there is not much coming up, so we will have a chance to relax a little.

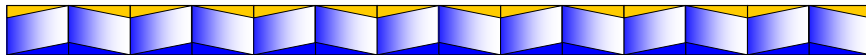

## NWFSRDA ANNUAL ROUND UP

### COMING SOON, TO A TOWN NEAR YOU!

Yes it is!! The wagons will be circling on October 30-31<sup>st</sup> for the NWFSRDA 41<sup>st</sup> Annual Round Up in Valparaiso, Florida.

The annual Round Up is a special dance, sponsored by the Northwest Association, in appreciation for the dancer's support of the Association.

Plans are being made to make this an occasion one that will fan your top and explode your wave! This year, as in past years, the dance date falls on the Halloween weekend so begin planning your entry into the costume contest NOW.

Although the association is able to finance a good bit of the dance expenses, it is still necessary for the dancers to help out. Each dancer will need to pay for a ribbon which assures entry to the dance on both days and, as chairmen, we will be asking for your help in some of the on-site tasks. Ribbons and fliers have been given to a delegate from each club and you can buy a ribbon anytime between now and the dance date. Ribbons will also be available at the door. General admission price is \$20.00 per ribbon but NWSRDA members pay only \$10.00. Just another benefit of being a member of the NWFSRDA.

One of the easiest ways that our dancers can help to defray the Round Up costs is to solicit local advertisers for ads in the dance booklet and to buy ads themselves. The costs are minimal and this would be an opportunity for individuals to expose their own businesses or to promote their employers to other dancers.

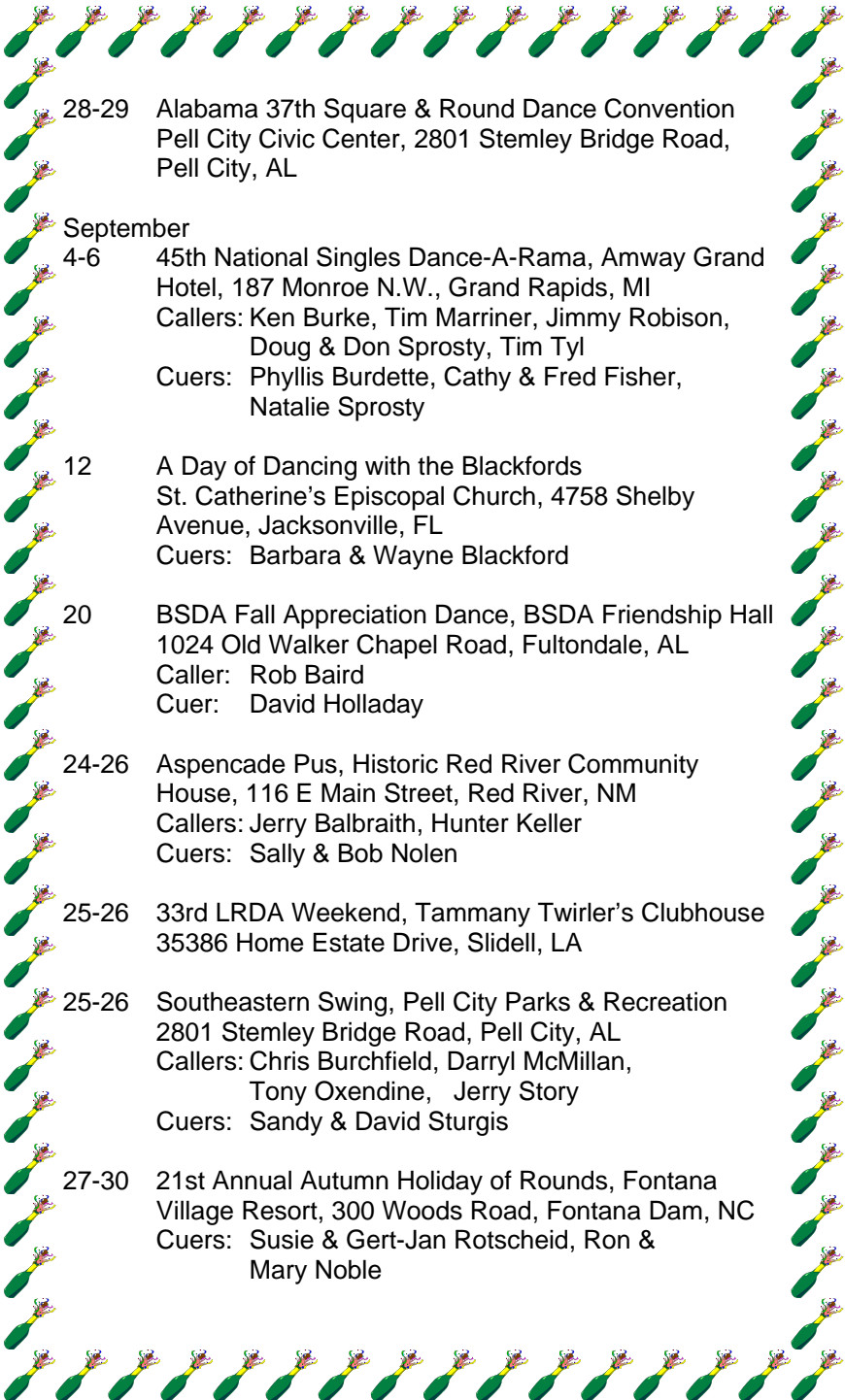

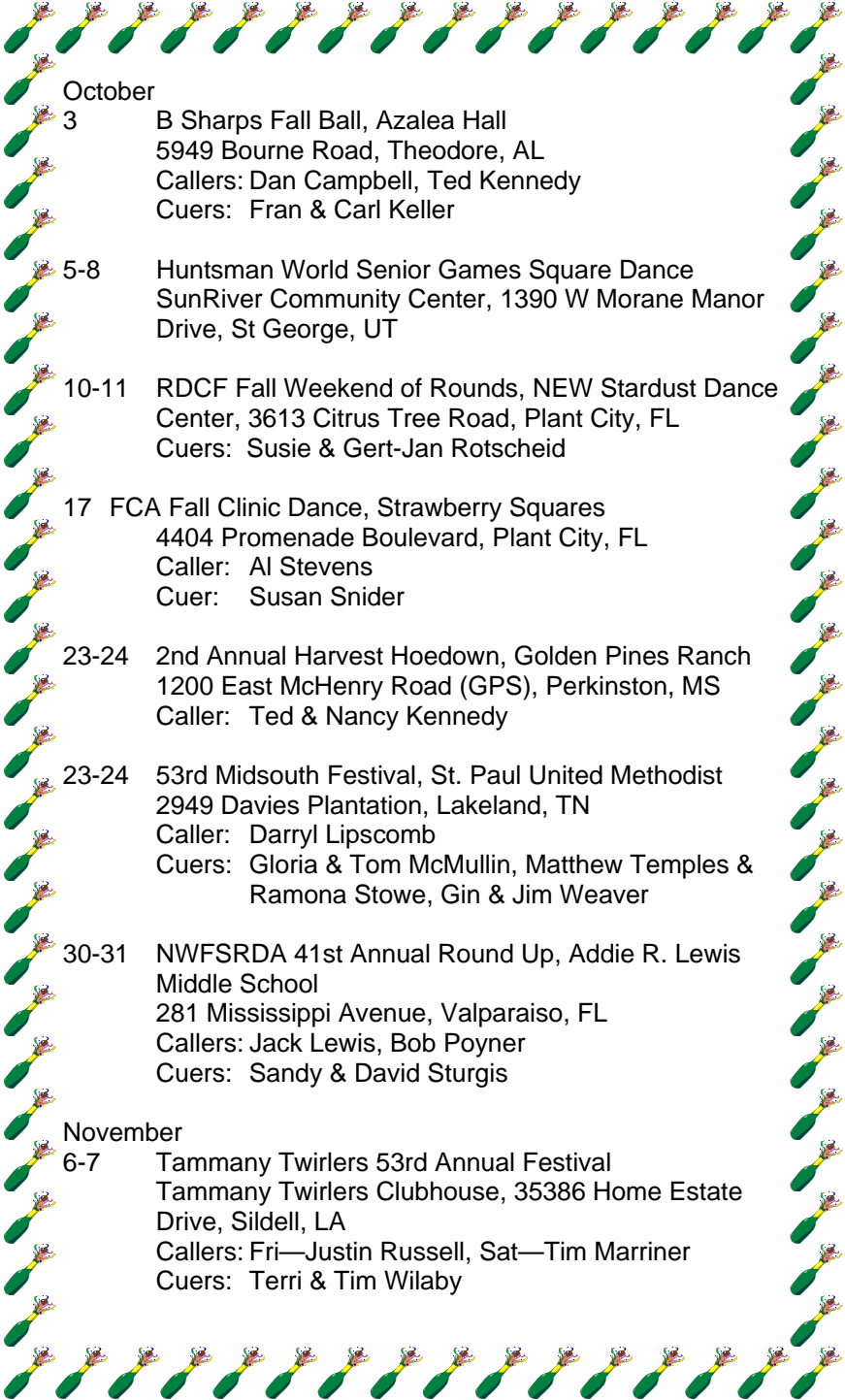

## CAPITAL TWIRLERS TALLAHASSEE

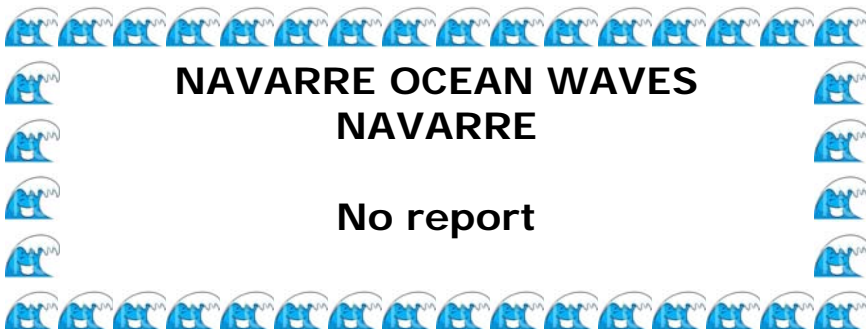

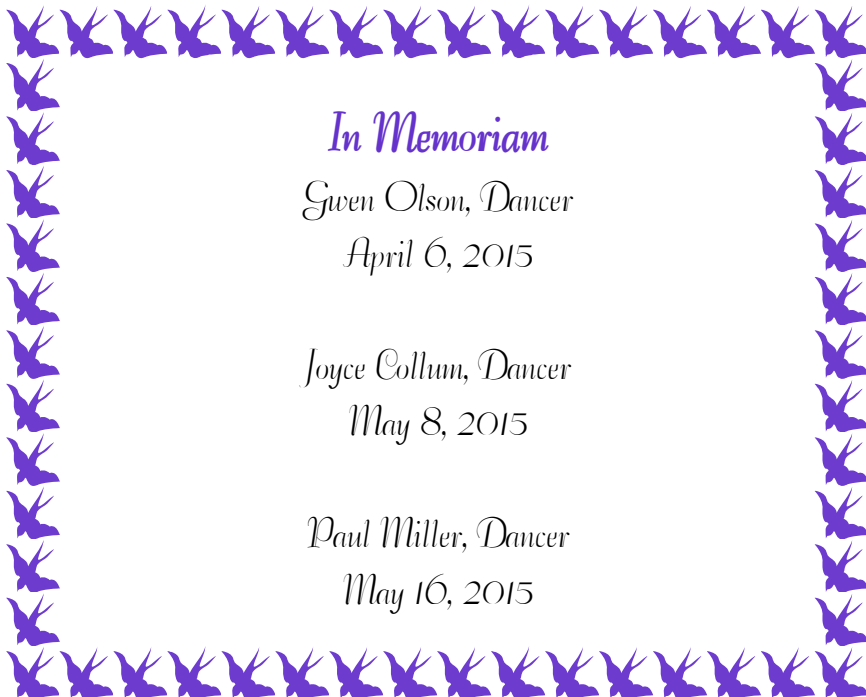

## SWINGING SQUARES PANAMA CITY




