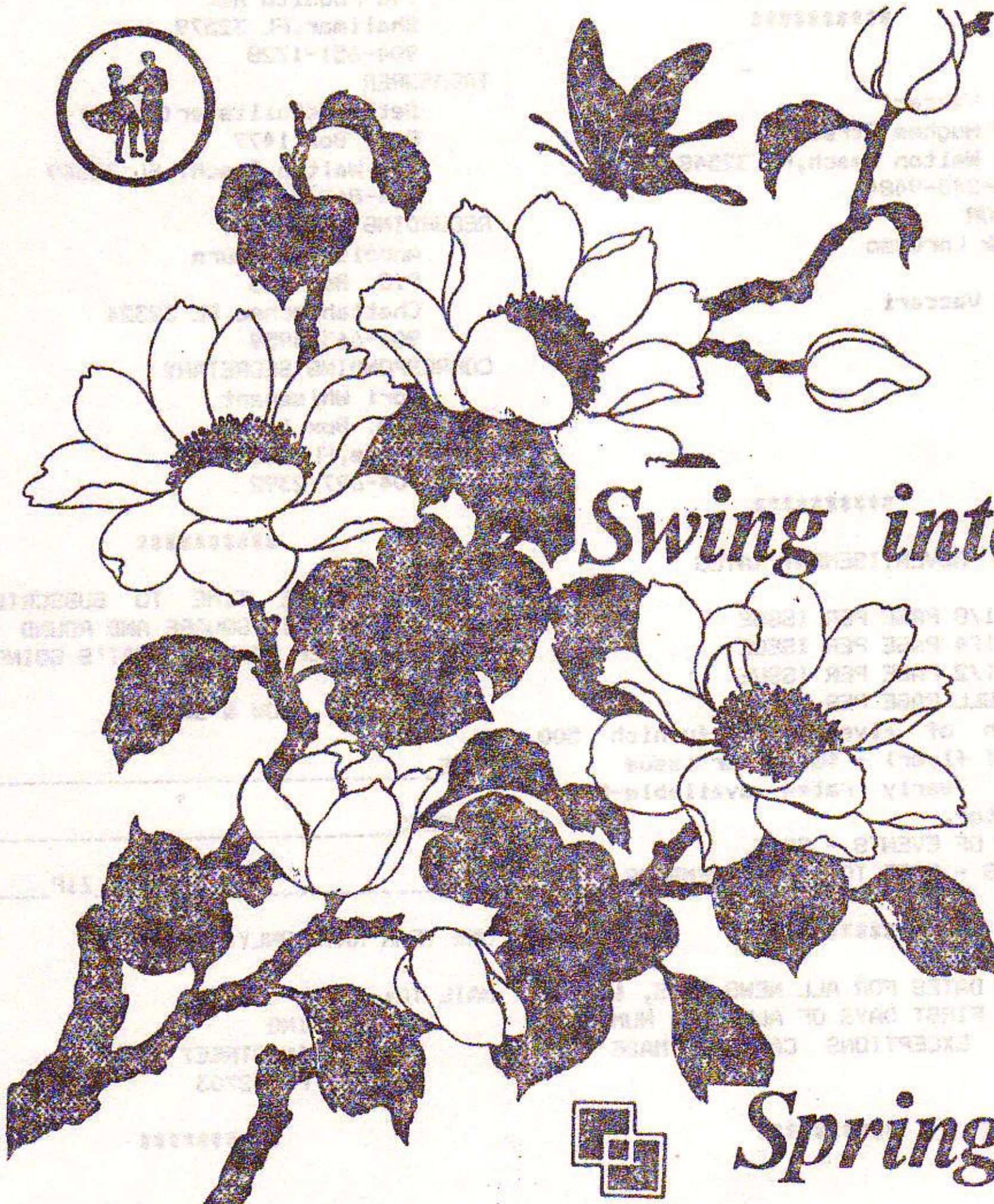

PUBLICITY RELEASE

33rd Florida State Square & Round Dance Convention  
May 23, 24, 25, 1986

Hosted by The Northwest Florida Square & Round Dance Association

The Convention Committee urges everyone to register prior to April 30, 1986 at the reduced rate of \$9.50 per person. No mail registrations will be accepted after the April 30 postmark. Fees at the Convention Box Office will be \$11.00 per person.

Following is a report of interest to cloggers, campers and Handicapable groups.

**CLOGGING:** Due to the Florida Clogging Council's Convention in Tampa at the same time the 1986 Square Dance Convention will not be using a separate facility for clogging. There will be a very limited clogging program for people who square dance and also clog or for members of square dance families who clog and do not square or round dance. For persons who clog only there will be a reduced entrance fee of \$5.00 which will allow only clogging and spectator activities. Anyone who has purchased a ticket to the convention for the purpose of a full clogging program may get a refund by returning your badges, along with a letter of explanation, to the registration chairman by April 30, 1986. The Florida Clogging Council will be providing instructors for the limited workshops and introduction to clogging sessions on Saturday and Sunday.

**CAMPING:** There have been rumors to the effect that camping in RV's would not be allowed this year at the Convention Site. This is NOT true and there will be ample parking in the Convention Center parking lot for self-contained RV's and Trailers. There are no hook-ups available so you must have your own water and electricity. There is a sanitary dump station available at the rear of the convention center parking lot (down by the lake) and this marked facility is the only place where any waste may be disposed of during the convention. Any unauthorized dumping will result in expulsion from the center and a heavy fine.

**HANDICAPABLE DANCING:** This is the first year that a room has been reserved for Handicapable Dancers. Frank Cherry, the Caller for the Pensacola Special Steppers, is in charge of scheduling for this room and will have full control of the room. All groups will be responsible for supplying their own callers/instructors for this highly specialized activity. If you desire to be included in the written program, please contact Frank Cherry or Frank McCallister as soon as possible.

Don't forget to mark your calendar.

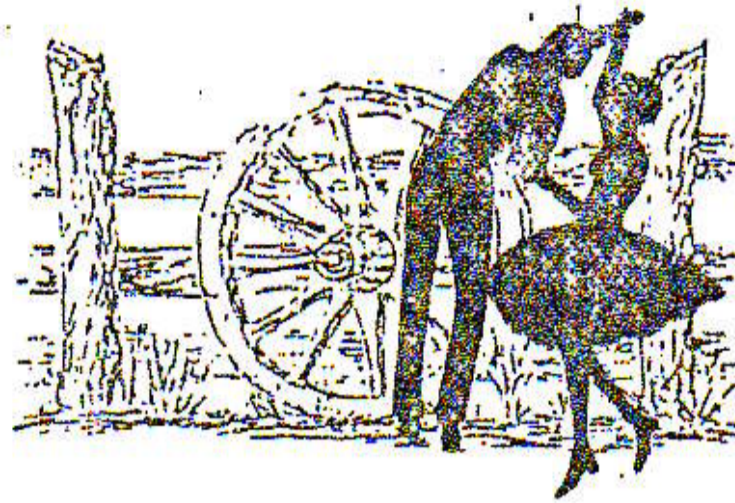

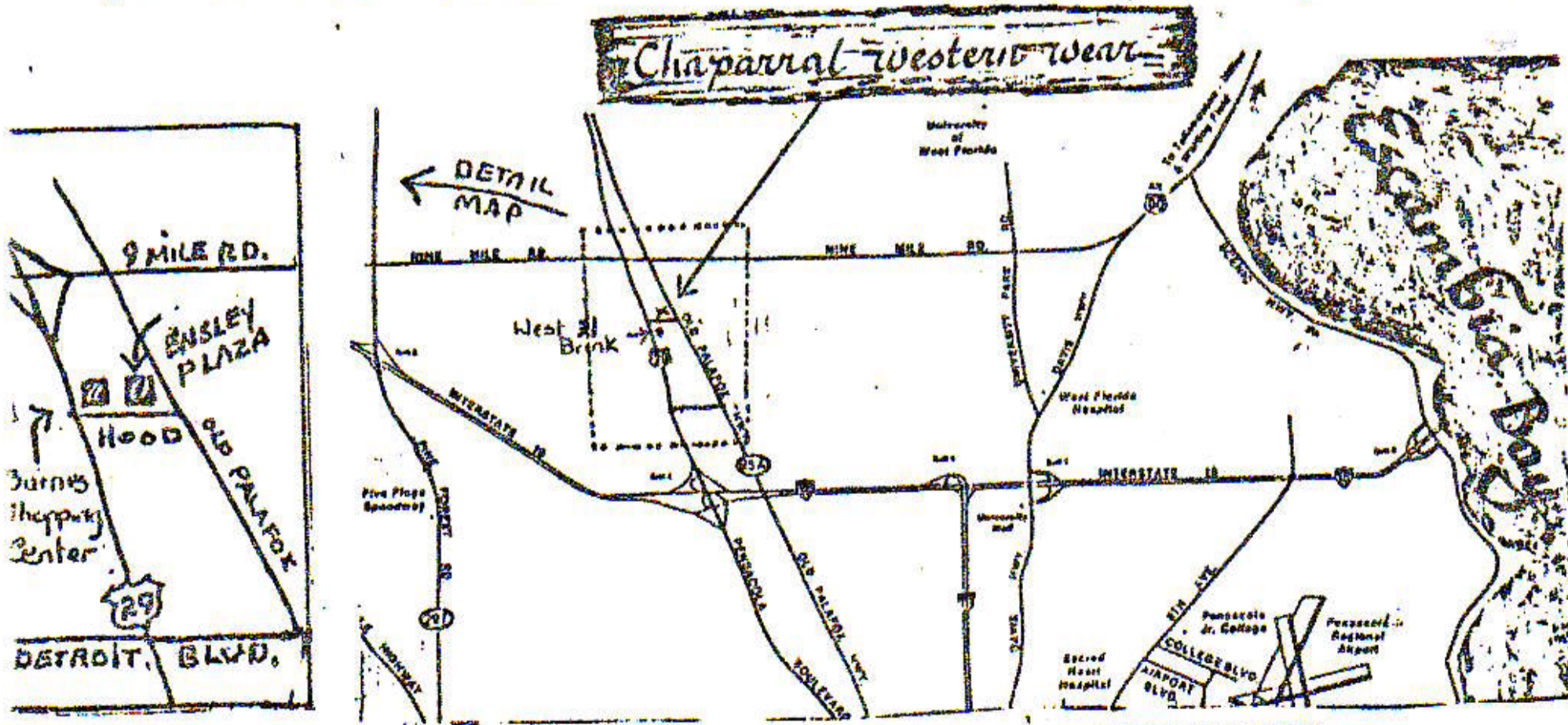

## SQUARE DANCE INSURANCE

Every Florida Square/Round/Clogging/Contra dancer organization needs general liability protection and accident medical expense benefits while conducting and sponsoring dance activities. As closely as safety rules are followed, accidents can and will happen. General Liability insurance protects the club officers and members from financial loss due to incidents or accidents which may develop into litigation against the member and dancer organization. Accident medical insurance protects the club member from unforeseen financial loss due to medical expense incurred as a result of an accident.

Complicating the problem is that the cost of obtaining insurance for dance groups has become prohibitive, especially liability insurance for an individual club or small association. For larger groups liability insurance is available but again the cost is high and often does not provide for more than one location nor does it cover injuries sustained by dancers while dancing.

Is your association, club and officers protected by insurance for general liability and bodily injury?

Your State Association, the Florida Federation of Square Dancers, as an affiliate of the United Square Dancers of America, is a participant in the economical insurance program offered by that organization. This insurance program was especially designed for square and round dance groups and is now available to associations and clubs in Florida. It provides for \$500,000 liability and \$10,000 accident/medical coverage plus other benefits, including certificates of additional insured for special events or when required by a property owner. The latter is becoming increasingly important as more owners of public or private facilities demand that groups show proof of liability insurance before they will be allowed to use the facility.

Cost of this coverage is only \$1.15 per club member; all club members must participate. However if a club member

belongs to more than one club they pay only one enrollment fee. Class members are also covered at no extra cost. The policy year is January 1 through December 31. There is no proration for partial year coverage.

Many clubs and dancers in Florida have enrolled in the FFSD/USDA insurance program. If your club is not enrolled and wants information contact your association insurance chairman.

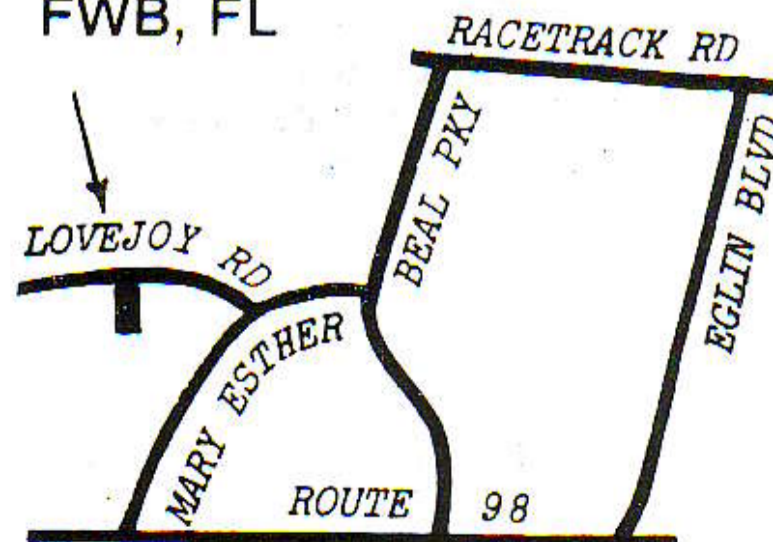

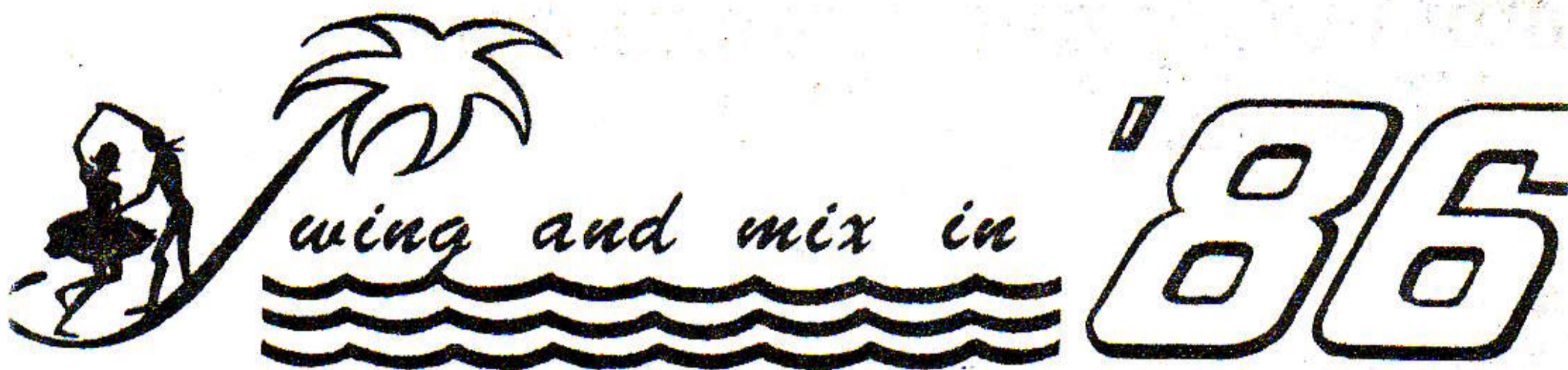

**THE INDIANA STATE FAIRGROUNDS, LOCATED JUST 15 MINUTES FROM THE CONVENTION CENTER IN DOWNTOWN INDIANAPOLIS, HAS BEEN CONTRACTED FOR USE BY CAMPERS DURING THE 35TH NATIONAL SQUARE DANCE CONVENTION. THE FAIRGROUNDS IS LOCATED AT 1201 EAST 38TH STREET — EASILY ACCESSIBLE FROM THE INTERSTATE SYSTEM. A DIRECTIONAL MAP WILL BE PROVIDED EACH CAMPER UPON CONFIRMATION OF REGISTRATION.**

**ALL CAMPERS MUST BE REGISTERED IN ADVANCE.** For your convenience registration packets, badges, etc. may be picked up at the camp office located on the fairgrounds.

**CAMPING FEE of \$60.00** covers camping from 9:00 a.m. Wednesday until noon Sunday. This is a flat fee with no extra charge for additional persons per unit. Early parking available Monday and Tuesday at cost of \$5.00/day.

**2000 SPACES** — Some on grass, some on asphalt — available on first-come first-serve basis. Units will be parked as they arrive. To insure a smooth flow of traffic and paperwork there will be no reserved spaces, nor may one camper "hold" a space for another. There will be no exceptions so remember — **TO CAMP TOGETHER, ARRIVE TOGETHER!** Sorry — no tent sites.

**LIMITED HOOK UPS** — every effort will be made to provide electrical hook up to every unit. Many water hook ups available — easy access to water for units not on direct hook up. Limited shower facilities. Ample restrooms. Refuse containers. Three onsite dumping stations. No pump out service, however portable holding tanks will be available on a scheduled basis, free of charge, should you not wish to move your RV prior to departure. Waste water will not be allowed to run onto the ground.

**A SEPARATE AREA** will be provided for those wishing to run generators.

**FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE** there will be on-site restaurant, ice station, pay telephones, postal pick up service, first aid station, RV parts and service store.

**AROUND THE CLOCK SECURITY** by fairgrounds patrol and our volunteers.

**FREE BUS TRANSPORTATION** available from fairgrounds to Convention Center on scheduled basis to registered campers only.

**NO GROUND FIRES PERMITTED,** however grills may be used as long as charcoal is disposed of properly — not dumped on ground.

**PETS ARE WELCOME** but must not be allowed to run loose. Please be considerate of others by cleaning up and disposing of waste properly.

Air conditioned hall available for trail end and after party dancing.

**MONITOR CB CHANNEL 4** for information and assistance.

The 35th National Square Dance Convention Camping Committee is making every possible effort to provide adequate and comfortable facilities, but please keep in mind this is not a conventional campground. Those wishing to use these facilities rather than "rough it at a hotel" must expect a few inconveniences (such as limited shower facilities) unless your RV is fully self contained. However, we guarantee that what we may lack in physical amenities will be more than compensated for through good old fashioned Hoosier Hospitality. We look forward to seeing you in 1986.

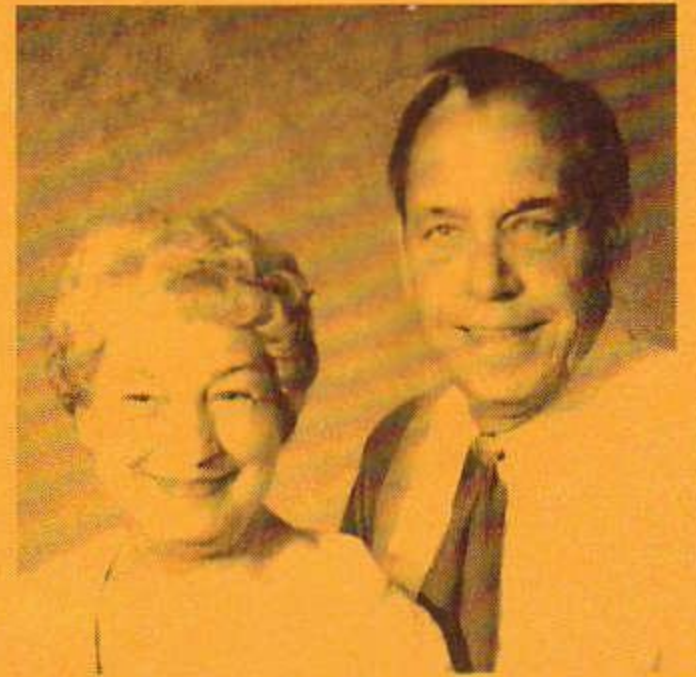
