Our Sound system and the hall acoustics will insure that callers can call and dancers can enjoy their calling and cuing. We guarantee it !!!

Our sound is being engineered and provided by square dancing professional sound technicians who have been working with us for more than 6 years. They have sounded nearly all of our California State Conventions, as well as large festivals and jamborees. These folks have been around long enough to know what it's all about.

The equipment to be used is square dance sound equipment. Hilton amplifiers and turntables will be used throughout the 19 dance halls.

Hope Sound, (our sound contractor), will provide continuous assistance all through the days of the convention. In addition, the Convention will have a sound monitor at each calling and cueing station to assist in any way needed.

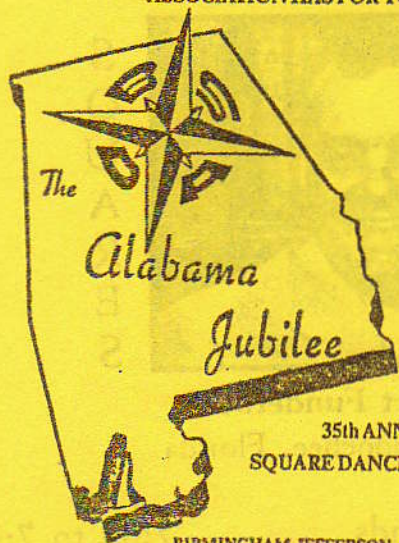

The Services Committee of the 1988 National Square Dance Convention in Anaheim is stressing the importance of strong advance preparations to deal with medical emergencies during the Convention. There will be trained CPR and First Aid volunteers on hand in every hall where there will be dancing. All staff members of the 37th National will be trained in CPR. Nurses, provided by the Anaheim Convention Center, have been hired by the 37th National Services-Committee to be on duty during the Convention. They will direct a large group of volunteers to provide thorough coverage in all dance halls.
