34TH FLORIDA STATE SQUARE AND ROUND DANCE CONVENTION

Here we are finally writing the last article before the State Convention. The program is being finalized and we are very proud of it. Earl Steele the Caller Vice Chairman and Frank DuBois the Round dance Vice Chairman have truly put the final touches on a program designed for you THE DANCER.

We understand that some dancers are unable to attend the whole weekend of dancing, If you can attend only one or two parts of the Convention Weekend a split fee is available at the door just for those segments you can attend. This is done to fit your particular situation and will allow you to attend this Convention and enjoy Florida's best callers and round dance leaders. Sally and I hope you will take advantage of this reduced fee and join us for part of the 34th State Square and Round Dance Convention if you are unable to attend the entire Festival.

To repeat some of the reasons we think you will enjoy this Convention there will be continuous open hall format, changing the stage in the arena for better sound, opening the plus hall to add more room and revision of the speaker set up, nearly doubling the hall for A-1 dancing, and planning over 12 hours for A-2 dancing. The round dance program has over 27 hours of pure round dancing and two rounds between tips in the mainstream, plus and A-1 halls. AN OPEN LETTER TO NORTHWEST CLUBS
AND DANCERS

Dear Fellow Dancers,

There is no question that Square Dancing is GREAT and BOOMING in Northwest Florida. This is evidenced by the largest number of clubs ever (40 plus), the many festivals and specials, and the greatest number of individual members in the Northwest Association. Enrollments in the insurance program stands at 1165, the highest ever. We have an outstanding Newsletter to keep us informed. We each receive a directory annually which details individual members, member clubs, Callers, Round dance instructors and other useful square dance information. Our annual Roundup is growing every year. The Northwest Florida Callers Association is going strong and doing much to benefit all clubs and dancers. All is Rosy, Right?

Not quite. In my view, the work done in past years by the Northwest Association (which is you and your club), has been instrumental, to a large degree, in what we are enjoying today. However, we cannot rest on our laurels and coast along. I see a major problem cropping up.

Attendance by club delegates at Northwest meetings has been dropping off. Less than half of member clubs were represented at the last three meetings. No club can be expected to be represented at every meeting (utopia); however, when clubs in the city where the meeting is being held do not send a delegate, then this certainly indicates something. Lack of interest? Let the other fellow do the work - or what? and we must also remember that the meeting usually brings three to four squares of dancers who probably wouldn't have attended the special dance otherwise. It must be said that some of the clubs not attending are the first to request special service on Insurance Certificates for their regular dance location and specials. Perhaps, if they had attended meetings they would have been better informed and certificates could have been issued on a routine basis without extra effort placed on the Insurance Chairman.

The Association needs the participation of every member club if

it is to continue to be of service to us all. The attitude to "Let George do it" or "I just want to ride" can prevail in any organization if we let it. I'm sure you don't want this to happen.

Stealing a line from ASARDA News, Alabama, Jim Segraves, Editor - Take a look at the cartoon - You'll get Nowhere! Club Presidents - won't you make sure that your club is represented at Northwest Association meetings. Dancers - Is your club represented and do you receive a report from your delegate? Let's not forget, the Association is you and your fellow dancers. It needs your input and support. We all benefit - Let's all do our share of the work.

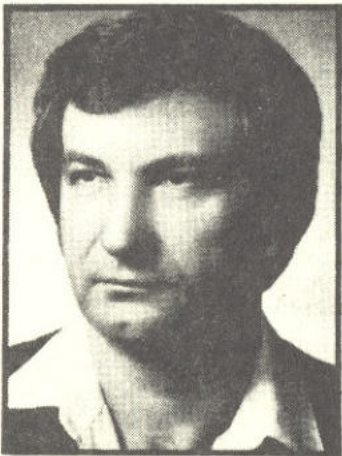
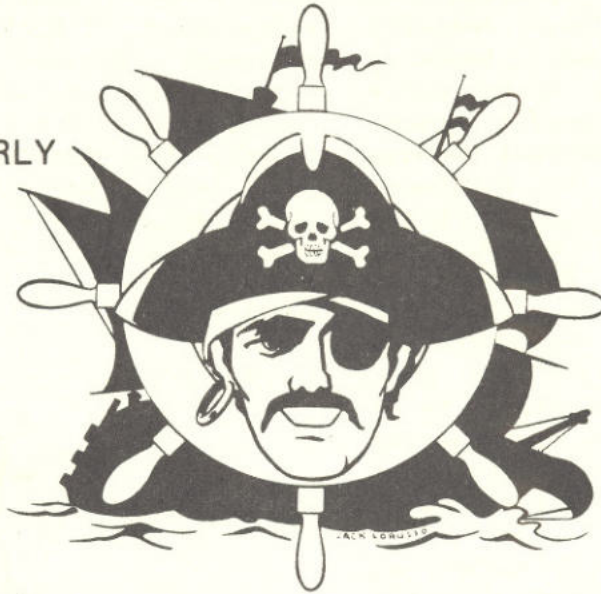

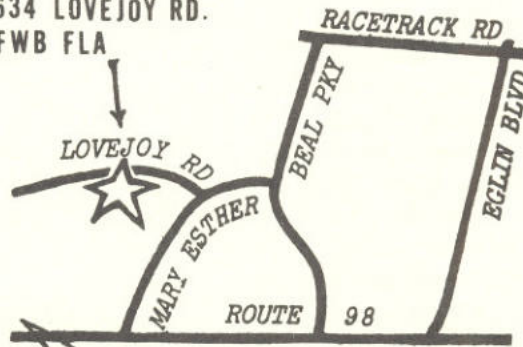
