The 2nd Roundup was a big success and everyone really enjoyed the bicentennial skit. Remember this was your dance and the only way to keep the Association going is with everyone's support.

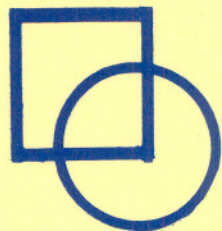
Something to think about and discuss at the next meeting is having another dance in 5 months or so to help raise some money.
