ON STAGE AT GRAND OLE OPRY

The INTERNATIONAL DANCE FESTIVAL for CLOG DANCERS, ROUND DANCERS, and SQUARE DANCERS will be held at the Grand Ole Opry House, Nashville, TN, on Thursday, Dec. 27, 1984, from Noon until Midnight.

A limited number of square dance and round dance clubs and clog dance teams will be given stage time to demonstrate or exhibit their dance. They will be mainly selected on a first to apply basis. Each club or team will be given a plaque with the words, "We danced on stage in the Grand Ole Opry House- December 27, 1984" engraved on it.

It is believed that this is a 'first' for Western Square Dance and Round Dance on the Opry stage.

Stan Burdick, AMERICAN SQUARE DANCE MAGAZINE publisher and Editor will be the Master of Ceremonies for the Square and Round Dance part of the festival.


The program includes the Grand Finals of the official World Clog Dance Championships. (the elementary, junior, and adult sections were held in Cherokee, N.C., Oct. 19-21) Teams and individuals will be awarded trophies and rosettes. The entire program is produced and directed by the FESTIVAL OF CHAMPIONS and by CLOGGING MAGAZINE, the official publication of the NATIONAL CLOGGERS ASSOCIATION. 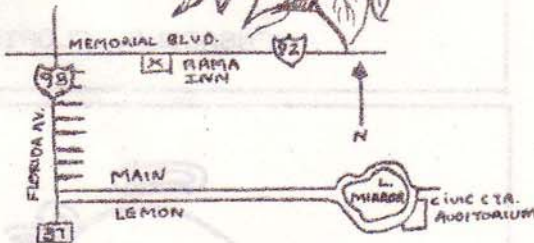

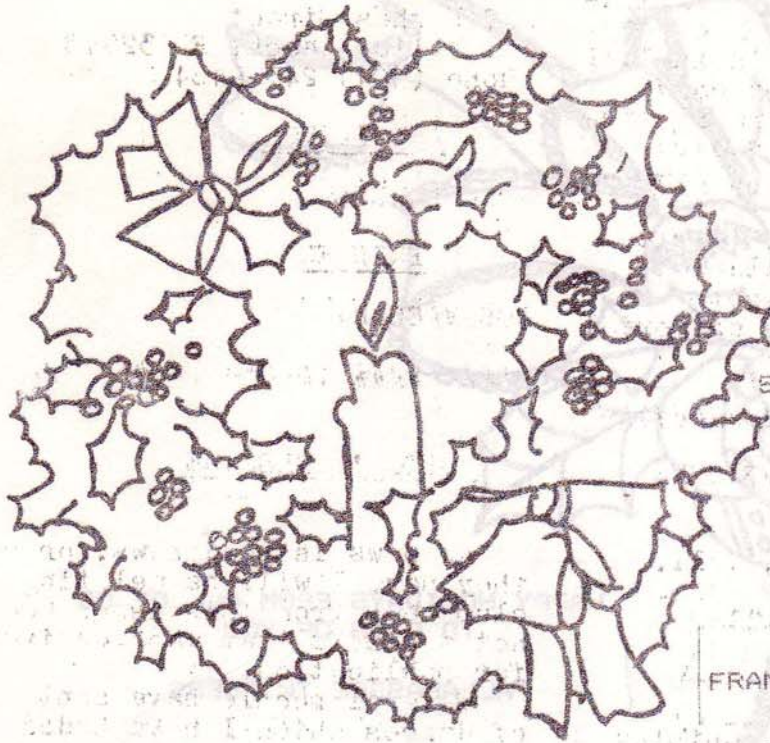

The 1985 Florida Square and Round Dance Convention Committee hopes that all of you have a very Merry Christmas and that this holiday season will be a joyful one.

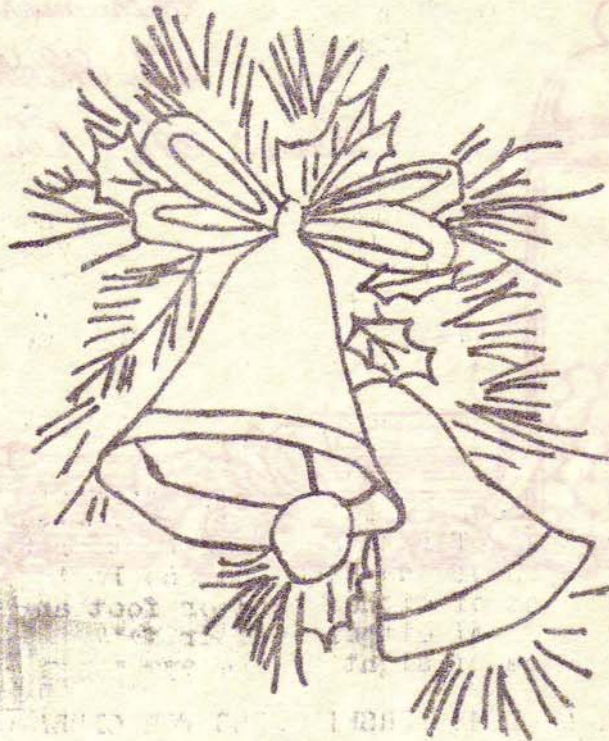
