

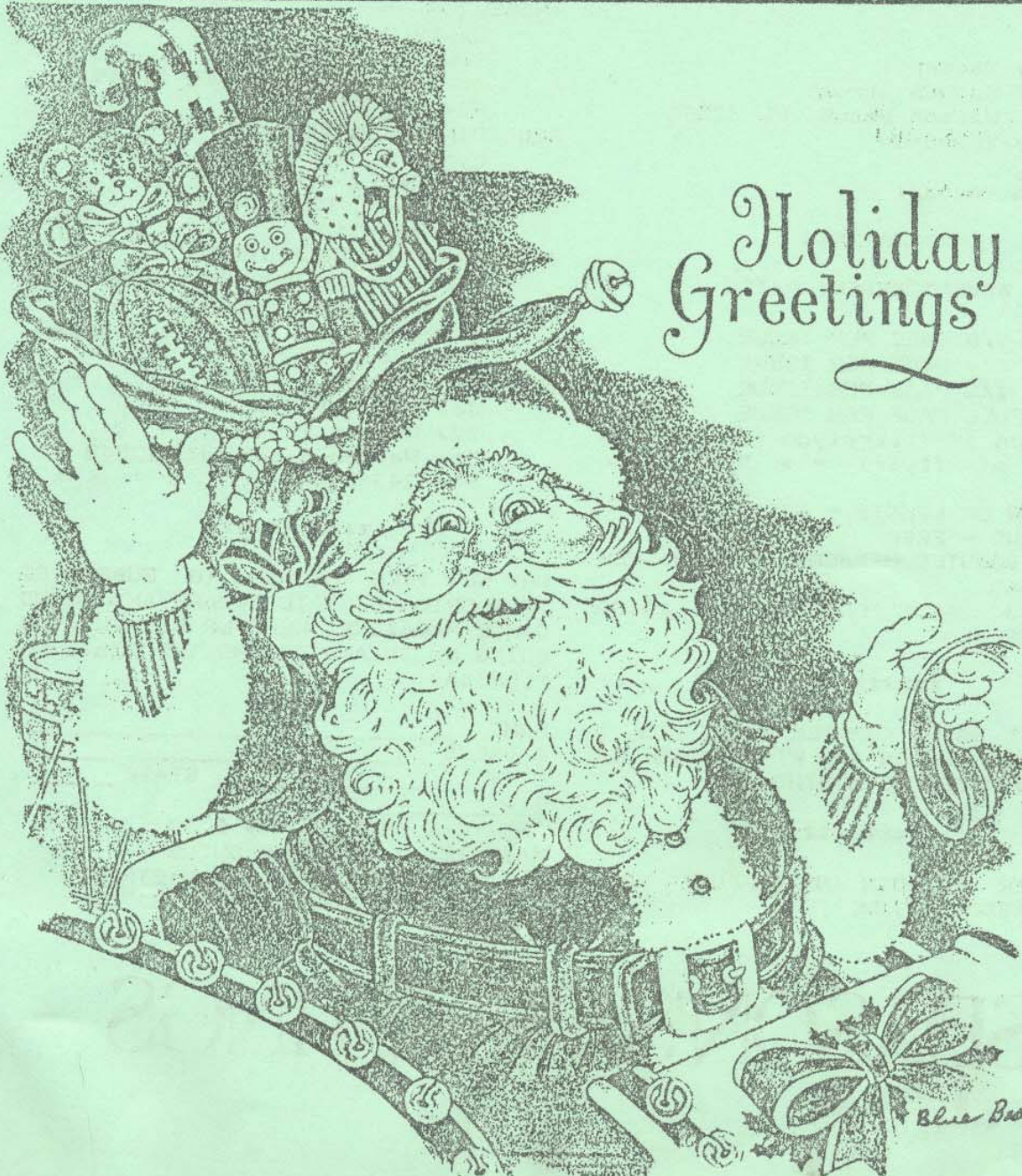

You may notice that the PANHANDLE PRESS looks a little bit different. This is the first issue done on my new computer. After I learn some new programs it still may change.

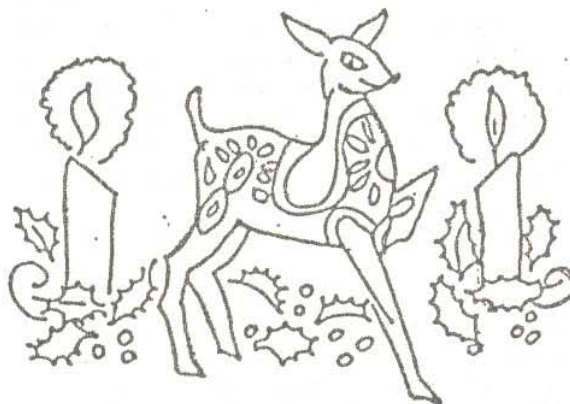

PRESS RELEASE

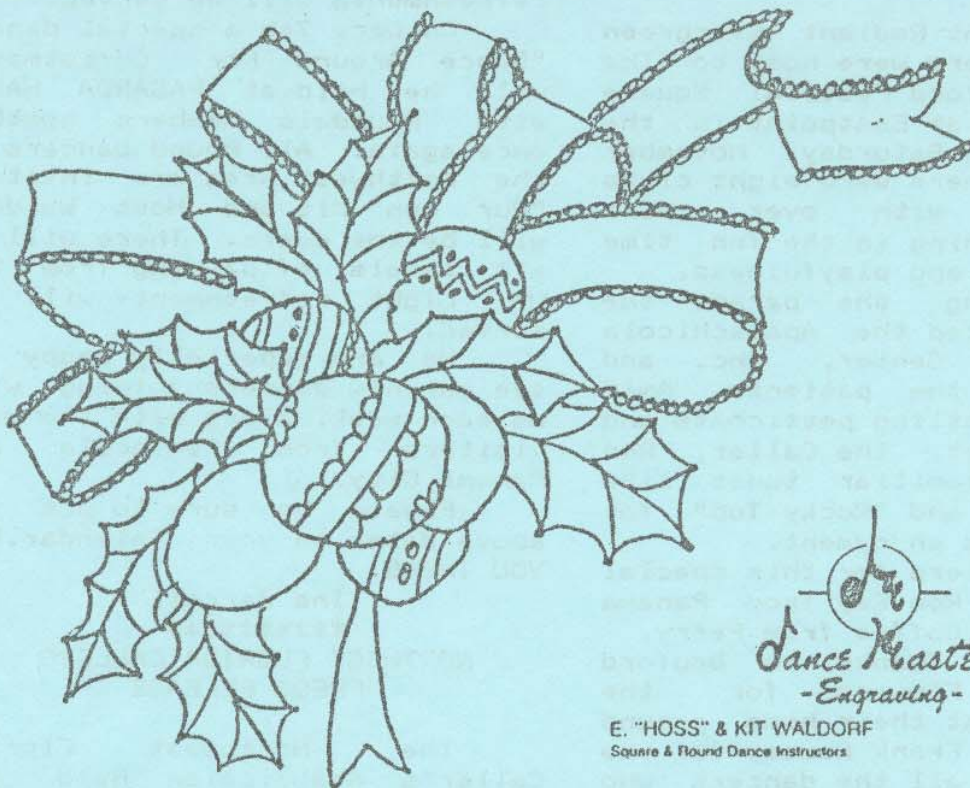

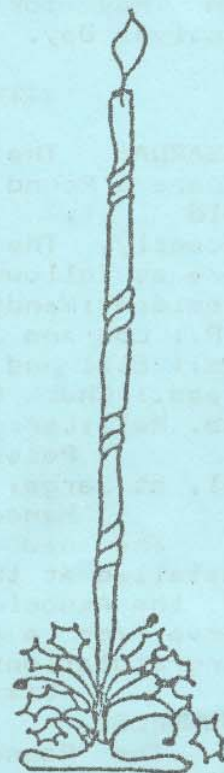

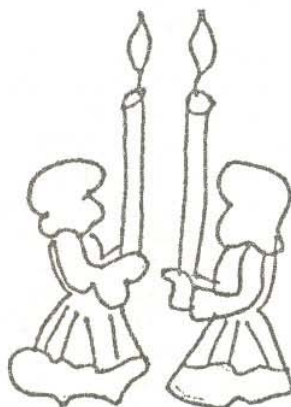

SQUARE DANCE INSURANCE

Your regional Association insurance chairman is currently enrolling clubs and dancers in the economical 1987 Square Dance Insurance Program that is available through the Florida Federation of Square Dancers and the United Square Dancers of America.

Every Florida Square/Round/Clogging/Contra dancer club or organization needs general Liability protection and Accident Medical coverage for its members. The insurance offered by the Florida Federation provides for \$1,000,000 General Liability and up to \$10,000 accident medical coverage plus other benefits including Certificates of Additional Insured at no additional cost. The latter is becoming increasingly important as more and more owners of public and private facilities demand groups to show proof of Liability Insurance before they will allow use of a facility. In some cases

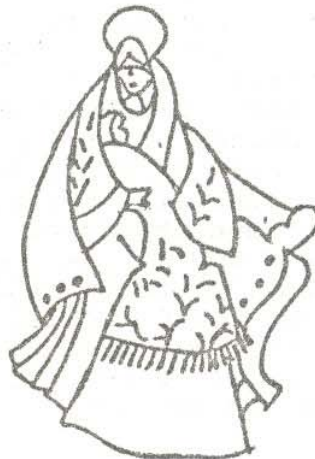
owners have required that they be named on the Certificate. This Insurance is available to any club or dancer affiliated with a Regional Dancer Organization.

Cost of this coverage is only \$1.85 per club member per year. All club members must participate. If a dancer belongs to more than one club they pay only one enrollment fee. Class members and new members joining a club after the club enrolls are automatically covered at no additional cost. The policy year is January 1 through December 31. There is no proration for partial year coverage.

It is urged that club leaders contact their Regional Insurance Chairman and avail themselves and their club of this protection. The insurance program is provided for you by your State Organization as a service to its members. Happy Dancing !

UNITED SQUARE DANCERS OF AMERICA  
MARK FIVE YEARS OF SUCCESS

The UNITED SQUARE DANCERS OF AMERICA celebrated its fifth anniversary and concluded its most successful year to date during their June 27, 1986, Annual Meeting held in Indiannapolis, Indiana. Attributing to the success achieved by this, the largest of all square dance organizations, has been the contributions of and effort by dedicated square dancer leaders from throughout the country.

New members approved during this year's meeting included the Old Pueblo Square Dance Association of Arizona, the Kansas Square Dance Association, and the Square Dance Federation of Minnesota. With the addition of these fine organizations, membership in the USDA has reached 180,000 square dancers in 22 states stretching from Massachusetts to California.

Remaining as Treasurer for a second year are Frank and Nan Habersberger from Florida. In addition to the responsibilities of Treasurer, this very capable couple will assume the duties as Chairman of the National Folk Dance Committee for the USDA effective January 1, 1986.

No aspect of the square dance activity is overlooked by the USDA. A unique program not offered by any other square dance organization is one designed for the Handicapable Dancers. The Handicapable Committee is Co-Chaired by Mac and Chieko MacKenzie and Frank and Nancy Cherry from Florida. It is the goal of this Committee to identify areas in which programs are currently available for the handicapped, to assist with the initiation of new programs, and to obtain recognition for this important aspect of the square dance movement.

Numerous other duties are assigned by the President to capable dancer leaders from all parts of the nation. Specifically the responsibility for the USDA's

National Organization Showcase of Ideas display at the National Square Dance Convention has been assumed by Joe and Joy Vaccari from Florida, also Past Presidents of the USDA.

Of considerable concern to any organization is the financing of its many activities. Assisting with this responsibility for the USDA are Ways and Means Committee Chairman Howard and Vivian Wilson, also from Florida. Through this Committee, the USDA offers many promotional items useful to the dancer. These include decals, memberships badges, USDA museum dangles, banners, and windbreakers.

The continued success of the USDA is a result of the dedicated service of its elected and appointed officers. Since this is strictly a dancers organization, no one is compensated for their efforts on behalf of USDA.

Arrangements are currently being made for the 1987 Mid-Year Meeting to be held for the first time in the Eastern Region of the USDA on January 23 and 24, 1987 in Rochester, New York.

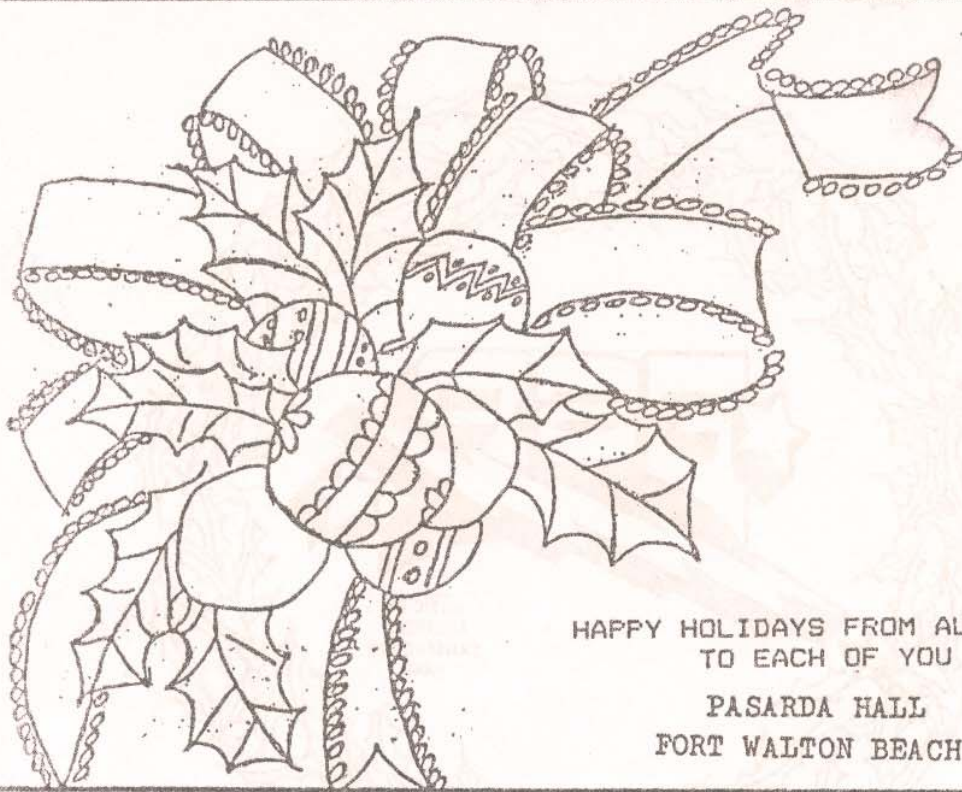

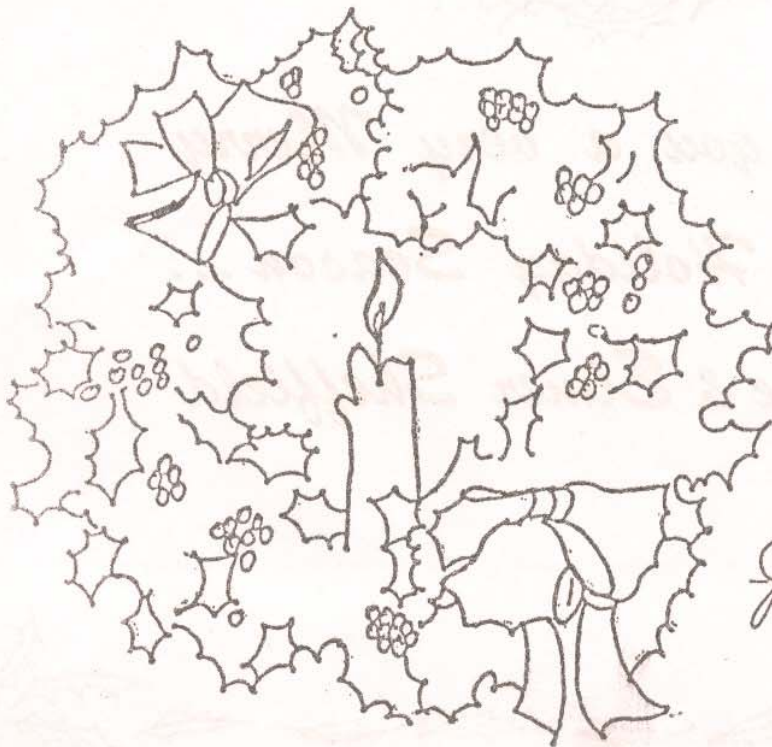


