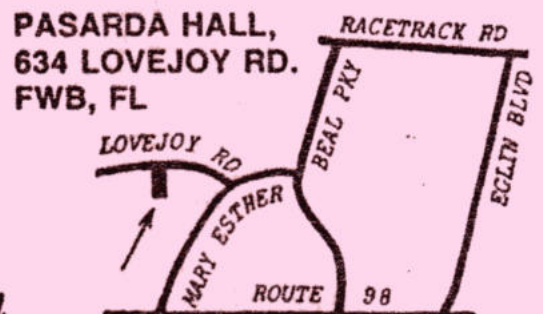

Five years later we must declare that the accomplishments on 1988 have represented a quantum leap towards this objective and we believe that it should be designated the YEAR OF THE HANDICAPABLE DANCER.

To those who have assisted in this progress, we would like to extend sincerest thanks:

Joe & Joy Vaccari, Past President, United Square Dancers of America (USDA) and their Executive Board who showed faith in our idea and our Committee in January 1984. Also their successors, Howard and Loraine Backus and Jim & Peggy Segraves and Executive Boards who have provided continuing moral and financial support to the program.

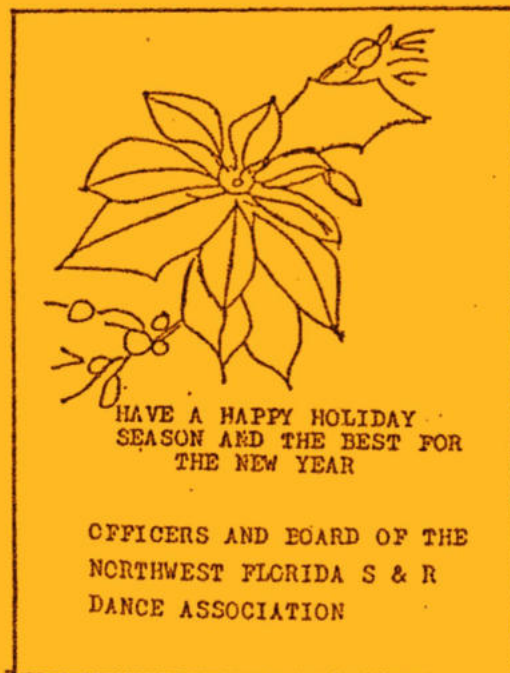
Marty Lackey, Editor, put out a very special Christmas issue featuring a Christmas scene and wishing "Peace on Earth".

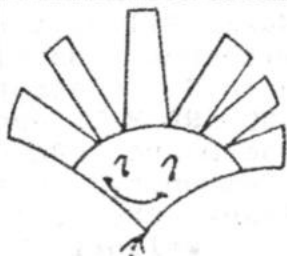
