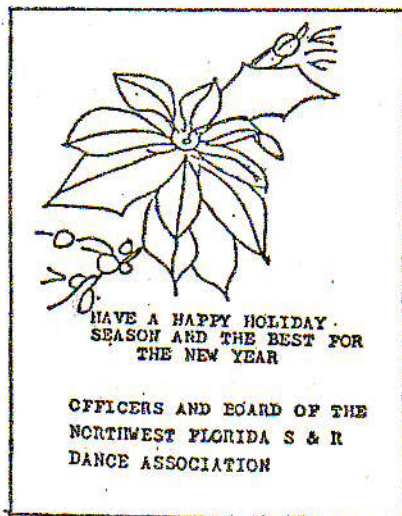

CREDIT CARD PROGRAM - A SUCCESS

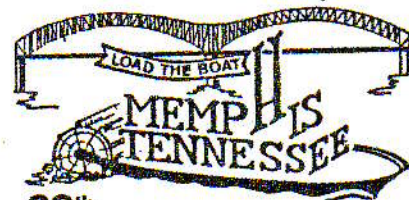

Our sincere thanks to the many dancers throughout the nation who have obtained the USDA Silver Mastercard - the credit card that identifies you as a Square Dancer.

You are helping to bring square dancing to the attention of the public wherever you use the card. Also you are supporting the activity by providing operating funds (at no additional cost to you) for use both nationally and locally.

The Square Dance Activity receives a portion of the annual membership fee for each card issued or renewed. Funds generated from the Credit Card Program can only be used to serve the dance activity in accordance with the USDA Charter non-profit status and IRS regulations. Administrative expenses are minor (telephone, postage, printing, etc.) since the program is operated by volunteer dancers. One third (1/3) of the surplus funds will be returned to the USDA Affiliates for their local use with the remainder retained for use at the national level.

The USDA Silver Mastercard is available to all dancers - square, round, cloggers, contra, line or heritage (except for Wisconsin and Iowa residents, precluded by their State Laws). DANCE-A-ROUND R/D CLUB; Panama City, FL

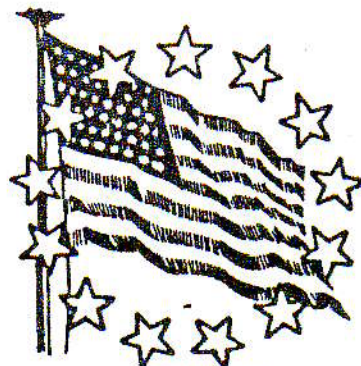
