You can come and dance to a great caller and not buy/order either the American Square Dance magazine and the National (& International) Square Dance Directory subscription. You are welcome to just dance. You also have the chance of saving \$8.50 off the regular price of the \$22.00 annual subscription of ASD magazine and a 10% savings off the Life Subscription for the National SD Directory, or just buy the current edition for \$7 there (first come first serve of what is available) or \$10 which includes postage and handling if you want to. The American Square Dance magazine is a monthly magazine that has articles about all aspects of Square Dancing: Basic, Line Dancing, Contra, Advanced & Challenge, record reviews for both Squares and Rounds, and more. The National (& International) Square Dance Directory is a great resource for finding where to square dance anywhere in the world. It also has a lot of resources for square dance clothes and equipment. The good part about its 'lifetime subscription' is that you can change your address every year and still get it sent to you. There will be samples of both the magazine and the directory for you to look at before you decide whether or not to order either or both. The caller, Nick Cline, has his own clubs in the Washington, D.C./Virginia area. He has also lived and called in such places as Germany, Japan, and Korea, besides many of the states in the USA. His scheduled dances this year have included places like Oslo, Norway; Charleston, WV; Vancouver Island, BC, Canada; Butte, MT; Salt Lake City, UT; Dallas, TX as well as others.
