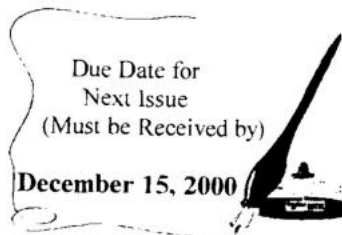

WHAT IS CALLERLAB DOING FOR SQUARE DANCING?

CALLERLAB, an international organization of nearly 2000 square dance callers, held its first convention in 1974. However, the roots of CALLERLAB go back to the mid 1960's. CALLERLAB people have been working in many ways to help square dancing since then. To help everyone understand CALLERLAB and what it is doing, we offer this list of accomplishments.

- More than 20 years ago, CALLERLAB members developed dance programs that have been accepted world wide. These dance programs let you go anywhere in the world and dance.
- CALLERLAB members documented and negotiated international agreement on the definition of all the calls we use. For the first time ever, calls were taught the same way in California as they were in New England - or old England, Germany, and everywhere else.
- CALLERLAB has printed and published thousands of pages of publications to help callers and dancers. These publications are used by dancers and callers everywhere, including the members of other square dance organizations.
- CALLERLAB members are featured in nearly all of the calling slots at the National Square Dance Convention and conduct the caller training sessions at these same conventions.
- CALLERLAB has established a Caller-Coach program to improve caller skills and thereby better serve dancers. CALLERLAB also provides a broad range of caller training sessions at its annual convention.
- When BMI & ASCAP threatened clubs in the U.S. with license fees for every dance, CALLERLAB and ROUNDALAB working together, negotiated a new form of licensing so that dance leaders could take over this obligation from the clubs.

National Folk Dance Legislation

A bill, HJR #60, has been introduced into the 106th Congress of the United States by Representative Jim Saxton from New Jersey to designate Square Dancing and its related activities as the National Folk Dance of the United States, in perpetuity. HJR #60 has now been referred to Committee of Government Reform in the U. S. House of Representatives for study and action. Indiana Representative Dan Burton is chairman of this committee. Right now this bill needs the support and backing from everyone involved in the Square Dance recreation.

LEGACY is contacting the many square and round dance organizations around the country asking their assistance in getting this bill accepted by the legislators. Please urge your members to contact their congressmen and congresswomen and request their support for HJR #60 when it reaches the floor for a vote. If you have questions, or want a copy of the resolution, contact the Co-Chairmen of the effort -Frank & Helen Cavanaugh at 20 Wooton Drive, Southampton, NJ 08088.

If possible the committee would like to have the bill signed by the President at the National Square Dance Convention in Baltimore. LEGACY feels passage of this bill will give square dancing and its related activities more visibility and have a positive effect in recruiting new dancers.

Thank you for your support in publicizing this bill We will need the help of all to get this bill out of committee and on to the floor for a successful vote.

Dues Renewal Time

As Roundup time approaches, we are reminded once again that Roundup time is membership renewal time. As Sandy and I are nearing the end of our fourth and final year as NWFSRDA treasurers, and will be passing on the duties to the new treasurers. We have a couple of hints which can make the transition, your membership renewal, and entry into the dance easier for everybody.

In order to avoid the long lines which sometimes form at the door, we recommend that you get your ribbons in advance. You can purchase your ribbons through your club representatives or through any NWFSRDA board member. This brown and gold beauty will look very sharp hanging behind your club or NWF name badge, and will provide a great deal of advertising for our annual event.

The ribbon, which cost only \$6.00 per NWF member entitles you to two nights of dancing, (Friday and Saturday nights) plus all the activities during the day Saturday. There will be something for everyone: Rounds of all levels, Square Dance workshops, Mainstream, Plus and Advanced halls, and for good measure, Line dancing will be on the schedule for the second year. The featured caller this year is Bob Baier, from Houston, Texas, and Jack White, Patty Ping and Ben Williams from the local area, and the two Bills, Bovard and Henkener for our Round Dancing pleasure. **All this for six bucks!**

Here's another way to avoid the long lines at the door. Have your membership renewal check made out in advance, so that all you have to do is hand it to us as you walk by. *Please write in the memo space that it is for NWF membership.* Remember, if there has been no change in your address, your phone number or name since last year, there is no need to fill out the membership form. For those who have experienced changes since last year, such as marriage (**congratulations**) or new address or phone number, we need that information on the renewal form. Note: If you have E-mail, please include your E-mail address on the membership form for us, so that we can update the NWF Master Roster. The Membership form is included in this copy of the PanHandle Press. Renewals are \$6.00 per member. Even better yet, if you **mail your renewal** to us, and **buy your ticket** in advance, the only reason you'll have for stopping at the door is for a yellow rock, and those are free. We'll always take time for a yellow rock.

The fee for new members is \$9.00 per person, or \$18.00 per couple. This includes the cost of a NWF Association badge. The yellow rocks are still free!
