BEEF STRIPS, LUAU STYLE

2 lbs.	Beef Round Steak, cut 1/2" thick	2 T	Vinegar
1 T	Lard or Drippings	2 T	Cornstarch
2	Onions "medium sliced 1/8" thick"	1/2 C	Soy Sauce
1/2 C	Water	1 Can (4 oz.)	Mushrooms
1/2 C	Brown Sugar "packed firmly"		stems and pieces
1 Can	(13 1/2 oz.) Pineapple Chunks	2	Tomatoes (medium)
1 t	Ground Ginger		peeled and wedged
		1	Avocado (medium) cut
			in strips

Slice steak with the grain in strips 1/8" thick by 2" long. Brown in drippings. Add sliced onions and water, cover and simmer 30 minutes. Drain pineapple and reserve syrup. Add enough water to make 2/3 cup. Mix brown sugar, ginger, cornstarch, soy sauce, vinegar and pineapple liquid. Add sauce, pineapple and undrained mushrooms to meat. Cover and cook 5 minutes. Fold in tomatoes and avocado and heat through. SERVE HOT over rice. Makes 6-8 servings.

1/4 lb.	Margarine	1 t	Dry Mustard
3/4 C	Brown Sugar	1 t	Molasses
1 C	Sour Cream		

Place in casserole and dot with margarine. Mix brown sugar and dry mustard and sprinkle this mixture over beans, stir-in molasses. Pour sour cream over mixture and mix gently. Bake in 350 oven 1 hour.

"Will any of you square dancers be traveling West this summer? If so, and you are near Penticton early in August, be sure to stop. Penticton is a small city in Eastern British Columbia on Highway 97, about a hundred miles North of the U. S. Border. It is in the Okanogan Valley where they grow so much fruit. Every year there is a regular country fair. At first square dancing was included with the fair, but it grew so big that they decided to give the dancers a week to themselves. So every year, the first full week in August the town is given over to the square dancers. They take over the baseball field which is covered completely with a plywood floor. Every morning a block downtown is roped off and dancing goes on and on. In fact a dance is liable to start up anywhere. Dancers and callers come from all over the States and Canada. A caller never calls more than once during the evening. If you want a lot of fun dancing with friendly people from all over the country, be sure to come. We will see you somewhere on the dance floor."

 4 Step together on R assuming Bfly-Pos M facing wall, tch L to R, -;

- 1-4 WALTZ AWAY; WALTZ TOGETHER (LCP); (Vine) SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE; THRU, SIDE, CLOSE;  
 1 From Bfly-Pos M facing wall release lead hands & waltz fwd turning slightly away from ptr L, R, L; (Progress LOD)  
 2 Waltz fwd turning twd ptr R, L, R to end in Loose-CP;  
 3 Vine LOD swd L, behind R (W XIB), swd L;
