- 1/4 lb. Butter
- 1 C Sugar
- 5 Eggs
- 1 T Spoon (heaping) Baking Powder
- 1 T Spoon Allspice
- 1 T Spoon Cinnamon
- 2 pkg. Bakers German Chocolate
- 1 Bott.le (small) Dark Karo Syrup
- 1 Box Seedless Raisins
- 3 Slices Candied Pineapple
- 1/4 lb. Candied Cherries
- 2 C Chopped Pecans
- 3 C Flour

Cream butter and sugar, add eggs one at a time-beat after each addition. Melt chocolate with a few drops of water in double boiler, stir smooth and add to creamed mixture. Add Karo and mix well. Add Raisins, fruit and pecans. Sift dry ingredients together and add to mixture.

Grease and flour jelly roll pan. Pour batter 1/2" to 3/4" thick. Bake 20 to 30 minutes in 350 degree oven. Cool in pan and icing while still warm.

ICING

Sift one box powdered sugar in bowl, add enough Bourbon Whiskey to make a creamy paste about consistency of white sauce. Spread on warm cookies. Cut in rectangles or squares. Orange juice may be used.
