Do not waiver--we have all been through!

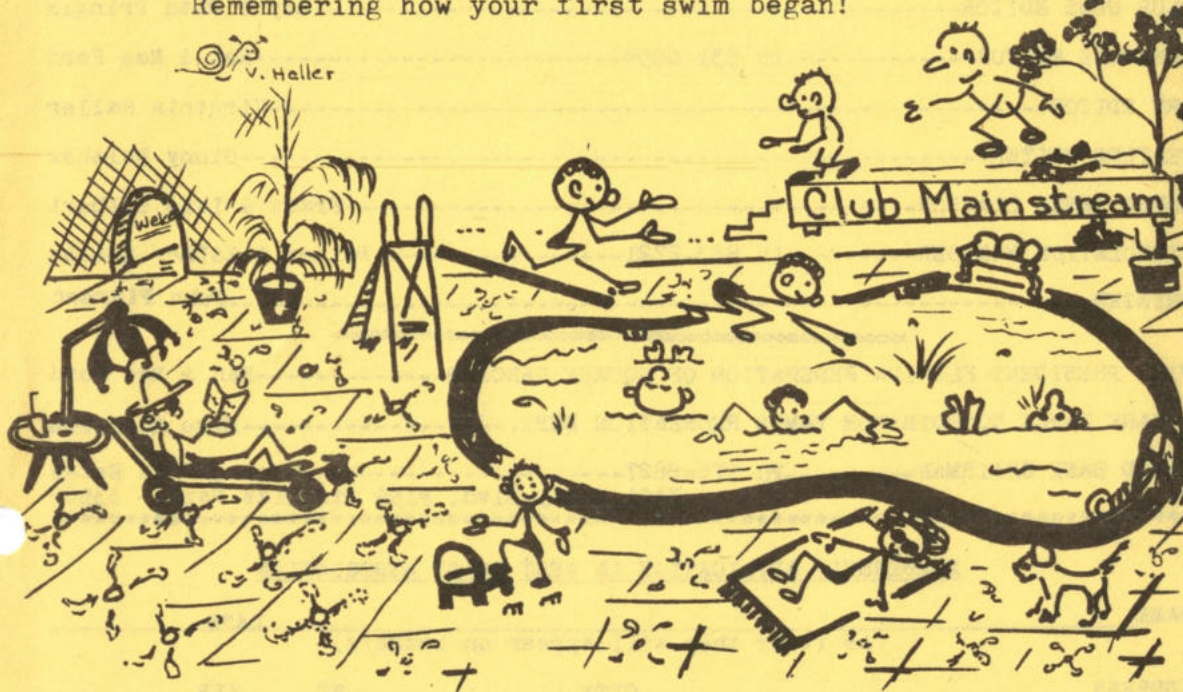
In a while--maybe a year or so,

PEANUT BUTTER PIE

- 1/3 cup butter or margarine
- 1 6-ounce pkg. semi-sweet chocolate morsels
- 3 cups rice cereal

In medium saucepan, melt butter and chocolate morsels over low heat. Remove from heat; gently stir in cereal. Stir until cereal is coated with chocolate. Press in bottom and up sides of lightly greased 9-in. pie plate. Chill 2 to 3 hours. Fill with the following mixture. This makes one 9-in. crust.

FILLING

- 1/2 cup crunchy peanut butter
  - 3 oz. cream cheese
  - 1 cup powdered sugar
  - 9 oz. Cool Whip
- Softer cream cheese, blend in peanut butter. Slowly add powdered sugar. Mix in Cool Whip. Pour into pie shell and chill for 1 hour before serving.

For the quarter beginning April 1, 1981, Callerlab has selected RELEASE RECYCLE as the quarterly selection for use at mainstream dances. It should be workshopped before being used by mainstream clubs. However, this does not mean that all clubs or all dancers must use the call but rather it is for groups who like something extra.

\*\*\*\*\*

TEN COMMANDMENTS FOR SQUARE DANCING

1. Thou shalt square dance only for the fun, remembering all dancers must have fun or no dancer will have fun for long.
2. Thou shalt earn forgiveness of thy goofs by remembering that even thou wert once a beginner and shall help those with less experience, while maintaining both a friendly face and a cheerful heart.
3. Thou shalt dance exuberantly, but shall act thy age.
4. Thou shalt remember square dancing is a social activity, dressing appropriately and behaving properly.
5. Thou shalt welcome the stranger in thy midst with word and with deed, remembering that "a stranger is a friend I haven't met".
6. Thou shalt form squares promptly when the music starts, never sit out when needed to complete a square and never, never leave a square.
7. Thou shalt let the caller do the teaching---leave all conversation for the break period.
8. Thou shalt honor thy club and give it thy loyalty and service.
9. Thou shalt not kill thy club with bickering and complaints.
10. Thou shalt spread gladness and good cheer throughout the land, advising all and sundry that:

"SQUARE DANCING IS FRIENDSHIP SET TO MUSIC"
