### FLORIDA SQUARE AND ROUND DANCE HALL OF FAME AND MUESEUM

At the mid-winter meeting of the Florida Federation of Square Dancers a suggestion was made by Mori Sogolow to establish a Florida Square Dance Hall of Fame. Marty & Byrdie Martin have gladly offered the use of their hall as a permanent home. The Federation, callers and cuers have given their full support.

The mechanics and criteria have yet to be worked out by a committee of Mori Sogolow, Marty Martin, Art Springer and Chet Vetter. The basic concept for selection to the Hall of Fame will be square or round dancers, callers or cuers who have been involved in the Florida activity for ten years or more and have devoted much time and unselfish labor so as to have had a significant effect. Their pictures along with a resume of their accomplishments will adorn one wall of Strawberry Square. It is hoped a selection committee can be mutually agree upon at the earliest possible date.

Along with the Hall of Fame it is hoped to display on the other walls various memorabilia of the Florida square dance activity such as plaques from the National Showcase of Ideas, the old visitation keys and any other items of interest that can be found.

We would welcome your suggestions for Hall of Fame inductees along with a resumé of their accomplishments, especially those of the late 50's and 60's whether living or not. Any memorabilia you may have or can locate along with a brief history would be most welcome.

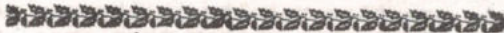

EDISON PAGEANT OF LIGHT

The square dance festival in connection with the 26th Annual Pageant of Light honoring Thomas Edison was held Feb. 15 in Fort Myers Exhibition Hall. DO SOMETHING POSITIVE

There are several things that threaten the enjoyment you generally expect to find at a square dance. Over most of these threats dancers have little or no control. True or not, it seems that the things most talked about have the least possibility of control. As an example, let's use the acoustical properties of your dance facility. If the sound properties are bad you generally can't do anything about it. If you like the dancers and the caller you can dance in different spots until you find one you like. Or, you can complain. That won't help, but, it might make you feel better. However, the biggest threat is dancer-caused and you can control it. It's too bad that some dancers don't.

The Mill Around Syndrome. It is inconceivable to think you can square dance and never make any mistakes. To err is human. But, to err with no plan of recovery is to sentence yourself to an interminable ten minutes of milling around. If the allemand left is not to be the reward for completing a routine, then let it be the reward for squaring up. Continued undirected motion will even take that away.

It doesn't matter whether you square up and wait for the next left allemande or square up and then make lines. Just do something positive. The most positive thing that can be done is to square up. If you want to form lines, that's okay too. However, lines are more easily obtained from a squared up set than from a milling mess. A square, square can do anything. All that happens with misguided movements is frustration.

It is unbelievable (but true) that some dancers have been told, "Just square up anywhere. It doesn't matter where. When you goof just go anywhere and start again." This practice results in the men not knowing whether they are heads or sides, let alone what number they are. Once this habit is learned, and another mistake made, the dancers that have learned it are doomed to mill around with mounting frustration until the tip has ended. Don't compound your mistakes. When you square up after a mix-up the men must go back where they started. Cure yourself of the mill around syndrome by knowing where you started and how to return there quickly. Compound your enjoyment, not your mistakes. Decide to do something positive. Learn how to square up.

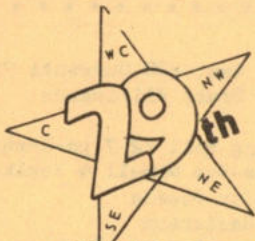
