

BLOOD BANK

APR. 83

The following information, concerning the blood bank operation, may be useful to dancers:

The age limit for donating blood may vary in blood banks. However, many blood banks accept blood from a healthy person up to age 80.

If one cares to make a donation to The Bank, he or she may go to any blood bank drawing station, (hospital, etc.), and request your donation be credited to West Coast Square and Round Dance Association. This account is with Community Blood Bank, St. Petersburg, Florida.

Only current members of the West Coast Square and Round Dance Association are eligible for blood. A member must notify the chairman of his need and the blood is released immediately. It is not necessary to be a donor to receive blood.

A new member has a thirty day waiting period, after joining the Association, before he or she is eligible for blood from The Bank. (This requirement is a part of the West Coast Association By-laws).

The blood bank is a very worthwhile fringe benefit for a West Coast Square and Round Dance Association member. So, will you please mail your 1983 dues or join this Association to-day?

The 1983 dues were due January 1, 1983.

WEST COAST SQUARE & ROUND DANCE ASSOCIATION



The West Coast Association was organized about 1956. It serves 14 counties on the West coast of Florida, from Citrus in the North to Collier in the South and includes Polk, Highlands, Desota and Hardee on the ridge. Membership has been on an individual basis since 1970 and as of 1982 more than 3000 dancers, callers and cuers belong to the WCA, making it the largest association of the five which comprise the Florida Federation.

The main purpose of the Association is to keep the dancers informed of events in square and round dancing on the West coast of Florida. This is accomplished through the publication of the West Coast Dancer, a monthly magazine devoted to club news, feature items, and a complete schedule of open dances in the area. The Dancer was started in 1968 and is supported by dues of the Association members, income from the Fall Fun Fest, and a share of any profit from the state convention when West Coast hosts that event. The 5000 copies a month are distributed free throughout our area.

One of the most worth while projects of the Association is an extremely successful Blood Bank established in 1976. Over 650 units have been donated to date. This is a service of inestimable value to West Coast members.

In 1965 the West Coast was host to its first state convention and has also been responsible for hosting increasingly successful conventions in 1969, 1973, 1977 and 1982 under the guidance of the Florida Federation of Square Dancers.

The West Coast Association owes its success to numerous corps of officers who have cheerfully donated untold hours of effort to promoting square & round dancing in the area.

Ceman's Chocolate Sugarless Cake

1 cup raisins (3 - 3½ oz boxes)	1½ cups of flour
1 cup water	1 tsp baking powder
1 square unsweetened baking chocolate	1 tsp baking soda
½ cup margarine (1 stick)	1 egg
1 cup chopped apples (3 med. size)	1½ tablespoons liquid sweetner
1 tsp vanilla	(sweet 10)

Boil water and raisins 5 mins in a 2 qt. pan. Remove from heat and add chocolate, margarine and apples. When mixture is cool, stir in flour, baking powder and soda. Add egg, liquid sweetener and vanilla. Beat 2 mins ----BY HAND. Bake in greased (or tinfoiled 8 x 10 pan,) 350° F for 30 mins. Cover and refrigerate when cool.
