Dear Mr. & Mrs. Estes:

Providing blood service to the hospitals in Pinellas County has been changing rapidly over the years---not only in the blood itself, but in the mechanisms used to meet patients' blood needs.

Effective April 1st, we will no longer need to charge a non-replacement fee to those unable to find someone to replace the blood used. This life giving substance is now available to all who need it.

Why this letter? We need your continued support to provide a safe, adequate blood supply for patients in our 12 hospitals.

we will send blood credits for your members who may be hospitalized outside this region if that blood bank charges a non-replacement fee.

The changes we are making are also being made by the Southwest Florida Blood Bank of Tampa and the Hunter Blood Bank of Clearwater.

The purpose of the changes outlined in the above letter is two-fold. First— To eventually include all blood banks and hospitals in our area in not charging a non-replacement fee, thus eliminating the need for blood credit accounts such as WCA's account. Second— To encourage residents of each community to supply the blood needs within their community.

Effective April 1st, the Community Blood Bank, St. Petersburg, will not accept blood credits from any other blood bank or hospital. Only those donations made at the main location or the Park Boulevard branch can be credited to WCA's account.

Mr. Doddridge's letter states that Southwest Florida Blood Bank and Hunter Blood Bank are making these same changes.

We know donors will continue to support the blood needs of his or her community, but since these donations will not be transferred to the WCA's account, you may want to establish a Family Plan with your blood bank or donate to an institution.

Your chairman will continue to transfer credits to hospitalized members if your hospital charges a non-replacement fee, provided the blood bank that supplies the blood is a member of the American Association of Blood Banks.

Whatever happened to the "Smooth Dancing" concept promulgated a few years ago by the National Convention Committee? Where has styling and grace, that once were a part of our scene, gone? What has transpired to convince some really top flight callers that expertise and speed are one and the same?

On most callers' equipment there is a knob which can be adjusted to a reasonable tempo, 125 to 128 beats per minute, which is slow enough to allow a modicum of style even for the aged and infirm and still remain fast enough for the speed addict. We dancers are not in competition with callers. We are not in a race to see who will finish first, if at all, because this is a contest we are doomed to lose.

There is another facet to this picture which gives the illusion of speed but is not speed itself and that is "stacking" or choreography. If too many calls of greater difficulty are stacked together, the dancer has no respite in which to regroup and identify with the proper position in order not to become confused. This confusion leads to a mad scramble akin to an adult version of "pussy wants a corner", all very frustrating to the dancer.

We realize that a caller is charged with presenting an interesting and varied program and we agree heartily, however, he or she must recognize that it is the dancer who pays the piper and if Joe & Jane Curlique are standing motionless in a broken square they are not having fun.
