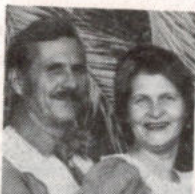

THE SQUARE DANCERS OF THE SHOOTIN STARS TOOK UP A COLLECTION IN MEMORY OF ROSE KRAUS WHO DIED LAST MONTH, SHE WAS THE REPORTER FROM THE SHOOTIN STARS FOR THE WEST COAST DANCER.

I've been trying to get familiarized with our Blood Bank status since being named Chairman, and would like to pass on a few facts in an effort to renew some of your interest in becoming donors for our accounts.

The Tampa Bay area uses 230 units per day! That means that every 12 to 14 minutes someone needs a unit of blood or some of its derivatives. There is no substitute for blood - it is truly man-made - no synthetic substitutes for it, so it must come from caring donors. Blood is needed for accident victims, leukemia, surgical, burn, dialysis patients, and hemophiliacs - the list goes on and on.

It is impossible to get A.I.D.S. from donating blood. The donor program has suffered from this misconception. Only sterile, disposable materials are used. There is absolutely no reason to be afraid - don't let misinformation stop you from giving blood.

We have two accounts to credit you for your donation of blood to the West Coast Dancer. Any of the branches connected with the Southwest Florida Blood Bank (Brandon Hospital, Town & Country Hospital, Tampa General, St. Joseph's Hospital, the USF Campus at Holly & 30th Streets, and any of the SWF Bloodmobiles.) Also, for those of you who live in Pinellas and surrounding counties, the Community Blood Bank, at 445-31st Street North, St. Petersburg. Just be sure when you donate the blood that you specify that you want credit to go to the West Coast Square and Round Dance Assn. account. They will send me a notice each month who has contributed, and your name will be published in this column.

Two years ago 85% of the blood banks throughout the US went off the credit system because they no longer charge a non-replacement fee. However, if you are hospitalized in one of the 15% that do charge a fee if you don't replace the blood yourself, ask your hospital to notify me and a unit or units will be transferred to you so you will not have to pay the fee because you can't replace the blood used. The important thing - those of us who can give need to give for those who cannot.

We received a total of 39 donations during the year 1985. Let's see if we can more than double that for 1986! Remember, a blood donor is "good for life" "The life you save could be your own." Thank you for caring!
