



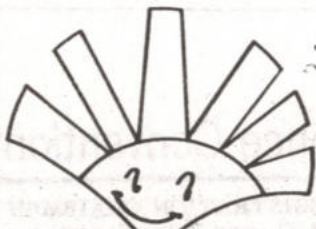

#### EDITORIAL

There is an old saying that goes "It's too good to be true". Sadly, we feel this must be the mistaken feeling about the USDA Insurance Program that is available to our member clubs. What other reason can there be for the lack of participation by our clubs in this very fine program? We cannot understand the hesitation by anyone or any club in taking part in this insurance program that provides both medical and liability coverage for only \$1.90 per person per year. The coverage for liability alone cannot be purchased anywhere for anything near this amount.

Not only is your club, but you, as a paid member of the club, are also protected from liability arising from accidents at a club dance. If you are in a square and accidentally bump, or kick, someone ( a visitor ) and they are hurt, the liability coverage protects you and your club from damages in a lawsuit arising from such injuries. You do not have to face the possibility of a drain on your personal finances. This alone makes the program worthwhile for anyone.

Please think about this, talk to your fellow club members, bring it up to your officers!

If you want more information, call Chris Nissen of the West Coast, or talk to your area VP's. We will gladly provide you with more information about this low cost coverage.
