We enjoyed participating in the exhibition at the Florida State Fair. We'll be looking forward to dancing with you at the State Convention. Swinging Grandma

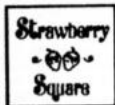
STRAWBERRY SQUARE - PLANT CITY

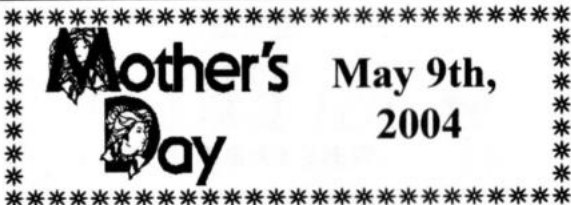
