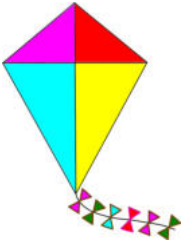

2014 - 2015 WCSRDA **PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE**

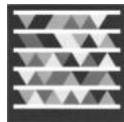
All of our seasonal clubs have closed for the summer. We have some places in the West Coast Association area that only dance three months out of the year due the departure of our northern friends - southwest Florida, Highlands County (Sebring), Pasco County (Zephyrhills), and Brooksville. Strawberry Square will only be open occasionally during the summer.

Sadly, I was notified in April that Glen Haven Squares in Zephyrhills has folded as they have lost the hall they danced in for years and again, no one wanted to step up and be an officer. May 9th will be the last dance for Bay Area Twirlers (BATS) of Brandon who have been dancing for 52 years.

Our association is experiencing the same problems as these clubs. We continue to operate without a secretary, a sunshine chairman, and a Lee County Rep. I even resorted to asking the members of the Suncoast Callers & Cuers Association if any of them would be willing to be a county rep. I was able to fill one position with two callers working on it together.

Our last West Coast membership dance of the season was on March 8th at the Palace Square Dance Hall in Arcadia. Nine to 10 squares danced the afternoon away with Dave Magee, Bob Avery, Mike Gormley, West Morris, Ted Hughes, and Robert Arias calling and Russ Collier, Jennie Martin, and Lone and Wally Wade cueing. Dave Magee, Wes Morris, Russ Collier and the Wades came all the way from southwest Florida and Ted Hughes came from St. Pete. We really appreciate the support of the SCCA as they volunteer their time to call and/or cue for our membership dances or they come just to dance. As a thank you for all their support, the West Coast Association will be providing lunch for them at their meeting in May where they will be electing new officers.

We had several new dancer classes going this year; now all we have to do is to keep them dancing! We had two beginner balls this year - one at Strawberry Square in March and one in Wauchula the end of April. The dance at Strawberry Square pulled new dancers from the Tampa Bay area and the Wauchula dance pulled new dancers from Highlands County, Port Charlotte, as well as Arcadia and Wauchula. Strawberry Square is going to try something new this summer to get new dancers into classes. It is being advertised as a 12-week class, the first two classes will be free, and everyone is encouraged to pay the 10 remaining classes up front (instead of week by week). Five different callers (Sam Dunn, Roland Blanchette, Keith Stevens, Ron Reardon, and Marty Vanwart) will rotate teaching classes. This class will start Monday, June 1st.

I have been attempting to get out to all the dances to promote the state convention in Lakeland May 22 - 24. I was side-lined for about four weeks in April due to back surgery but I am back at work making my visits.

We suffered a great loss back in March with the passing of Larry Clevenger. Larry was a member of Buttons & Bows of Lakeland since 1958. He served as president three times and in just about every other office and committee chair position. Even when he could no longer dance, he and his wife Dorry came to every dance and collected dance fees and sold 50/50 tickets until they could no longer do that. When there was a Knothead Konvention, he and Dorry attended everyone until the last one that Art and Martha Springer held. They had the most years of attendance at that Konvention and each year they were called to the stage to receive a new bar for that recognition. I can't even begin to guess how many banner raids and retrievals they went on or how many times we had meetings and parties at their house. In 2013 we gave them Lifetime Membership in the club. He is survived by Dorry, two children, and one grandson.

PARK 'N' RIDE BUS PASS **Dancers coming for the day**

Coming to dance, not staying at a contracted Hotel / Motel, staying with family / friends. Park at the Big E - take a free ride to the MassMutual Center to purchase a bus pass if you have not already done so on your convention long form. The pass costs \$50.00 for each person riding the bus. The bus runs only between the Big E and the MassMutual and your car has in and out privileges from the Big E. Keep an entrance tag in your car for free admission into the fairground.

Each contracted convention hotel will be on a bus loop. You can request a bus pass on your registration long form for \$50.00 per individual rider. You can get a bus pass at convention for \$60.00 per rider. Each bus loop will go from the hotel to the MassMutual Center at 30 minute intervals. Leave your car at the hotel at no charge. The Bus Pass does not include residents parking in garages at the Sheraton or Marriott Hotels. Their parking fees are set by their parking authority.

West Coast Association's **41st Annual Fall Fun Fest**

Forty-one years of holding the West Coast Association Fall Fun Fest and each year it gets better and better!

This year it will be held on November 13 - 14 at the Bartow Civic Center in Bartow, Florida. Tim Marriner and Ross Howell will be calling and Jimmy and Carol Griffin will be cueing. The levels of dancing will be Mainstream, Plus, and Advance and Phase 2 - 4 in Rounds.. Good news; the Advance hall will be larger this year!

The Strawberry Square Store will be our vendor again this year. If you're not familiar with this store, it is the one at the Strawberry Square Dance Center. They are a full service store - shoes, men's and women's attire, crinolines, and accessories. I'm sure you'll find something in the store that you just can't do without so start saving your money!

The schedule includes workshops for Squares and Rounds, dances on Friday night and Saturday night, and a Round Dance demo and a Square Dance demo.

The advance cost for the entire weekend is \$18 per person; at the door it is \$20 per person. If you can't make it for the whole weekend, split rates are available at \$10 per person for dancing either Friday night or Saturday night or all day on Saturday for \$15 per person.

If you need a break from the dancing, there's plenty to do in the area. Bartow is a small quaint historic town at the intersection of Highways 98 and 60. The downtown area will be blocked off on Saturday for a craft and antique fair.

There are numerous restaurants; some local mom and pop establishments and several chain restaurants that you are familiar with. There are also a couple of tea rooms in historic homes where you can have lunch. Free camping is available to the first ten rigs to arrive at the Bartow Civic Center. Parking is also free!

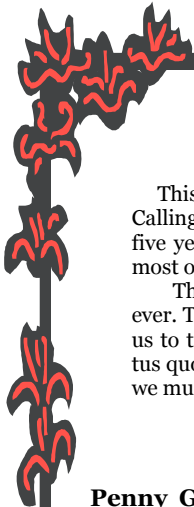

Frequently Asked Questions

1. We will be driving to the convention. We need to know where to park our car where it will be safe as we attend the convention. We want the most economical means available. We are not familiar with the area.

Answer: Springfield is growing and parking lots are being taken out of service for construction of a casino. Parking is at a premium. If you are housed at any hotels listed with Convention Registration & Housing, you may leave your car parked at your hotel, buy a bus pass (\$50 per person) and do all your travel on a bus to and from the Convention Center. We have created four bus routes for hotel transportation to reduce the length of time on the bus. From the hotels outside the routed area, park your car at the Eastern States Exposition / Big E gated lot. There is bus transportation exclusively for the parking and camping. A bus pass at \$50 per person is required to be transported back to your car (no parking fee). The Big E is 1.5 miles from the Convention Center.

2. If I don't eat seafood, have food allergies, or am looking for vegetarian selections, what food choices will I have in Springfield?

Answer: All restaurants will make exceptions, offering vegetarian selections as well as their specialties. Springfield offers food options of poultry, beef, pork as well as seafood. We have fast food and full meals at any level of sophistication you desire. If you enjoy ethnic foods, we have that as well. Check at the Convention Center for our "Eating Out" display with the restaurant map and menus from the multitude of restaurants in Springfield. They all know you're coming!

3. Do we square dance at any time during any of the tours. I am wondering about how to pack for this. I would love to leave stuff in the car and take only what is needed.

Answer: All Half-day, 1-day and Multi-day tours during the week do not include dancing. We will be square dancing only on the 6-day New England Adventure Tour. We will dance in all 6 states so you can earn your USDA Traveler's Badge signatures. These dances will be short "more like a flash mob" in casual traveling clothes - no dressing up for these dances.

4. Are there any hidden costs, gratuities to be added, extra items that must be purchased while on tour? I am talking about big expenses.

Answer: No, everything is included in the tour price. When purchasing meals or merchandise on your own, expect sales tax of not more than 7%. If you feel that a person did a great job, please extend them the extra gratuities.

5. How does the insurance work as far as cancellations, if we have to cancel any events?

Answer: Follow the cancellation policy on the Insurance Application Form from the 64nsdc.org website set up by The Travel Group.

6. Is there any free time on the tours?

Answer: On any of the Half-day, 1-day and Multi-Day tours, the Tours Brochure will indicate meals, shopping and free time on your own. On the 6-Day New England Adventure, we have specific times for some arranged tours and events with short times for browsing & visiting.

7. Is there a shuttle to and from the airport and Amtrak?

Answer: Yes, for Bradley International Airport, contact Valet Park of America 1-800-599-8916. For you on Amtrak, take a taxi waiting outside the station.

8. Can we buy a bus pass after we get to the Convention?

Answer: Yes, we offer two different bus passes. For contracted hotels through our Convention Registration & Housing, you can purchase a bus pass when you pick up your packet for \$60 (\$50 prior to Convention). For non-contracted hotels, we strongly urge you to buy the Park & Ride Shuttle Pass for \$50 per person (this includes the parking fee and issues you the auto admission tag for your mirror). Originating at the Eastern States Exposition / Big E / Convention Campground this is a secure parking area for your personal vehicle parking. The parking lot at the Big E is 1.5 miles from the Convention Center supplied by an exclusive bus route. Your hotel reservation will verify your ability to purchase this Big E pass.

9. Is there any dancing earlier in the week?

Answer: Yes, starting Sun, Mon, & Tues there will be round dancing at the Sheraton Hotel with Roundalab. At the MassMutual Center, starting on Tues there is square dancing with Tony Oxendine and Grand Squares, Inc national callers. On Wed night The Ghost Riders with Tony Oxendine square dance after the dinner & show and two other Trail-In dances take place that night at the MMC. Check the website for Trail Thru dances prior to convention and dancing schedules in Springfield the week of convention.

10. If we go on the 6-Day New England Adventure, where do we park our car and where do we stay after we get back?

Answer: To prepare for the 6 day tour, you must sign in at the Sheraton Monarch Place Hotel and board your luggage on the bus. For those returning to the Sheraton, your extra luggage can be stored at the hotel for your return. Those needing secure parking, you will drive to the Big E Gated lot and be picked up there by the bus. After the tour, you will be returned to your vehicle. To have a room for overnight when you return from the New England Tour, **you must book prior to the trip and using the following websites only.**

You may wish to stay at the Sheraton Monarch Place Hotel in Springfield for \$89 per night + tax {WEBSITE: <https://www.starwoodmeeting.com/StarGroupsWeb/res?id=1408117632&key=33DB3984>}.

If you are taking a plane, you can reserve at the Sheraton at the Bradley International Airport in Hartford, CT

The bus will take you to this hotel at the airport terminal convenient to your flight for \$98 per night + tax.
