### Kitchen Kolumn by Ginny Walther PASTITSIO

1/2 # gr. beef, 1/2 C Chopped onion, 1/2 clove minced garlic. Cook until browned. Stir occasionally. Then add: 1 can tomatoes, cut up, 1/2 t. salt, 1/8 t. pepper, 1/8 t. cinnamon, simmer 15 min. Stir in: 1/4 C grated Parmesan Cheese, 1 Box (8 oz) cooked elbow macaroni. Turn into 12/8/2 inch baking dish: set aside. Melt in med. sauce pan 3 tbs. oleo, blend in 1/3 C. flour & 1/4 t. salt, stir in gradually 2  $\frac{1}{4}$  (1/4) C. milk-cook until thickened, cool slightly. Beat in, 1 at a time, 3 eggs; stir in 1/4 C cheese. Pour over meat mixture. Put in preheated oven 400 degrees. Lower temp. to 375 and bake 30 or 40 minutes or until top is golden brown.  
May be frozen after baking!  
You'll find this to be a real treat.
