WEST COAST MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the West Coast Association is down - way down!

If you are a square dancer in the West Coast Area (that includes 16 counties), you should be a member of your Association.

Your Association does realize that not every single dancer can attend every single dance put on by your Association (free); nor does every single dancer need blood (free); nor does every single dancer have the square dancer's insurance (about \$2.00 a year), but they should; and not every single dancer reads this magazine (free), but there sure are a lot that do.

You may find it hard to believe that at the present time there are approximately 1,200 current (1996) members of the West Coast Association. And this is even harder to believe - during the winter season, 4,000 magazines are printed and distributed and during a couple of months in the summer, there are only 2,500 magazines printed. Does this make sense? Either we have 2 or 3 thousand visitor dancers coming into our area or we have a lot of West Coast dancers that ARE NOT members.

There are two (2) sources of income to pay for this magazine - your membership in your Association and your attendance at the Fall Fun Fest (which LOST money last year)!

We wonder if anyone realizes the work that goes into getting this magazine to you: such as telephone calls, setting the type, design work, buying supplies (and paper would be a biggee), printing the magazine, lugging those magazines to our dancers that do the collating, folding, counting and bundling up of those magazines, taking the magazines to all the various areas and then it gets to the dances for the dancers to pick up (free)!

The point we are getting at - membership in your Association is down, much lower than ever and therefore much less money is coming in, so PLEASE renew your membership in your Association. Even though you don't take advantage of all the benefits of your West Coast Association, it is your Association and you are certainly helping to keep square dancing alive, something we should all be concerned about.

If you stop and think of all the West Coast Association does with the amount of money that comes in, it's amazing. To renew your Membership, the fee is only \$3.00 per dancer per year.

At the Florida Federation of Square Dancers Working Weekend February 17 and 18, 1996, it was approved to set in motion the process of selecting a NEW Florida State Square Dance Outfit.

Let it be known that anyone can submit an outfit, keeping the following guidelines in mind:

1. Keep the design simple with easy construction.
2. A design compatible to women of different sizes.
3. Availability of pattern.
4. Availability of material.
5. Accessories such as, shoes and petticoat, be a color the majority have.
6. Outfit should be for both men and women.
7. Outfits to be constructed and presented to Outfit Committee at February 1997, Working Weekend, along with a copy of pattern and logo.
8. Committee will select a minimum of three outfits to be displayed and voted upon at the full Federation assembly at the Sunday meeting.
Voting shall be by ballot only.

To avoid any conflict with the current Florida Federation State Outfit or the 1997 National Convention Outfits, we suggest the new outfit not be worn until 1998.

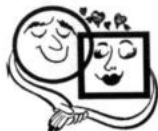
