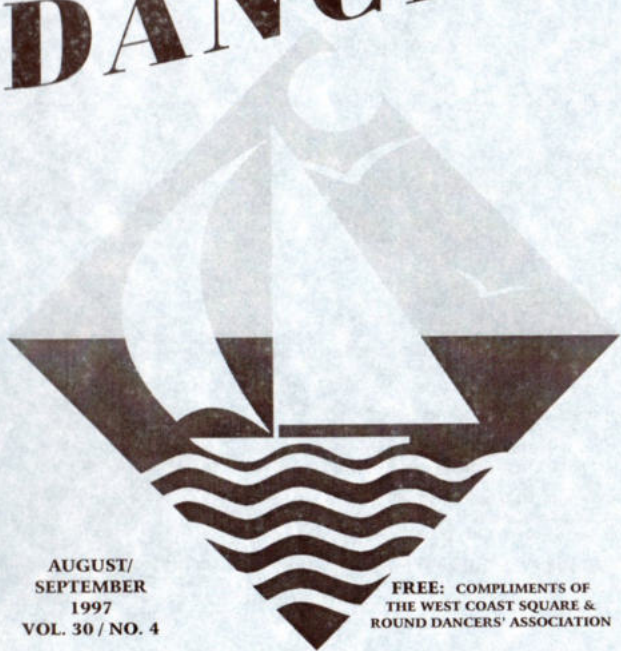

### **WEST COAST BANNER BANDIT**

**PURPOSE:** The object of the West Coast Banner Bandit is to promote the West Coast Square and Round Dancers' Association and the Fall Fun Fest: by

1. Visiting the various Clubs in the West Coast Area and stealing the Club's banner or get an I.O.U. (banner) from the Club. NOTE: If the Club gives the West Coast an I.O.U., the Club will be expected to give the West Coast their banner during the month of October.
2. The Club can retrieve their banner by sending a minimum of one square to the annual Fall Fun Fest dance.
3. The Club which retrieves their banner at the Fall Fun Fest and has the greatest number of members attending the annual dance will receive a plaque on Saturday evening during ceremonies.
4. The Club which retrieves their banner at the Fall Fun Fest and has the highest percentage of members attending the annual dance will receive a plaque on Saturday evening during the ceremonies. For instance, if a club has 38 members and 25 attend the Fall Fun Fest dance, the Club's percentage will be 67.8%.
5. All Clubs who retrieve their banner at the Fall Fun Fest will be recognized.
6. The Club's roster submitted for the U.S.D.A. Insurance Program will be used in determining the number of members in a Club.
7. The Florida Federation of Square Dancers Banner Stealing Guidelines will be used as the guide for stealing the Club's banners. (With noted exceptions)
9. Participation in the "West Coast Banner Bandit Program" is not compulsory.

### **CLUB BANNER BANDITS**

The West Coast Square and Round Dancers' Association will honor annually.

1. The Club which has the most Banner Bandits during the months from December 1 through October 31.
2. The Club which goes on the most Banner Raids during the months from December 1 through October 31. Banner Retrievals may not be included in the total number of Raids claimed.
3. Appropriate plaques will be presented to the Clubs at the Fall Fun Fest dance.
4. The West Coast Banner Bandit form will be used for purposes of determining number of Banner Raids and Banner Bandits.
5. The Florida Federation of Square Dancers Banner Stealing guidelines will be used as basis for stealing each others banner. Exception will be item #9. Substitute 45 days in place of 90 days.
6. Clubs wishing to participate in West Coast Program will send a notice of intent along with the Club's roster to the current Secretary of the West Coast Square and Round Dancers' Association.
