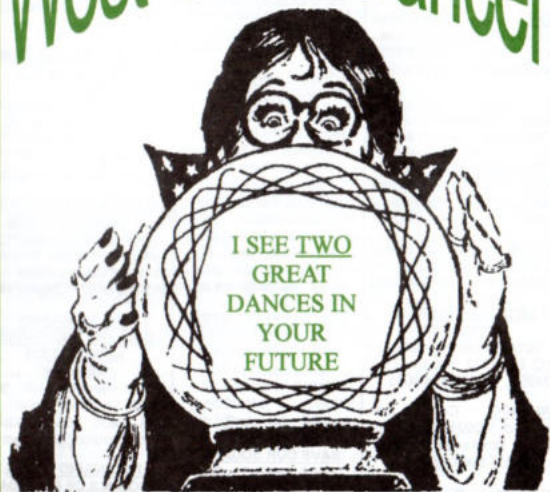

The Florida Dance Web

The Florida Dance Web has acquired the domain name, "squaredancing.org". It has been used to establish a website for newer dancers, class members and the non-dancing public.

At present, the site contains a promotional area on the front page plus a short history of square dancing, a CALLERLAB profile, an ethics section from an FSDA document, a media section which contains links to vendors who sell teaching aids such as video tapes, and the CALLERLAB definitions for the Mainstream program. Planned are a blurb about Legacy and the USDA. There are also buttons which link to the Florida Federation of Square Dancers and Florida Square Dance Callers Association where the visitor can find a dancer or caller contact in his/her area.

Go to <http://squaredancing.org> and look around. We welcome your suggestions as to content that would be helpful to our intended audience.

To promote the squaredancing.org site, the Florida Dance Web is providing free emails to any who want them. These emails can be used as a link to your club even if you don't have a website. They are also available for personal use. The email addresses will not be released to a third party and there will be no SPAM as a result of you signing up.

Each time you send an email using the squaredancing.org address, a message appears at the bottom of your content saying: Learn about square dancing at <http://squaredancing.org>. When the recipient clicks on the link, he/she will be taken to the squaredancing.org web site.

Help us to steer people to this new web site for the promotion of square dancing by applying for and using the yourname@squaredancing.org email system.

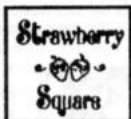
National caller J Larry Letson, has been booked to call at a special "fun plus" dance on Wednesday, September 19, 2001, from 7:00- 9:30 p.m.

RECRUITING & YOU

This is a response we got to our request for ideas on recruiting and maintaining dancers. We believe there are some good ideas and observations of problems with dancers and their relationship with new dancers.

Dear Ann & Don:

I saw your article in the Bow & Swing (June 2001). You said: "We would like to get all of you to submit some ideas to us no matter how crazy it might seem.... " Ok. you asked for it!

Some of the following 20+ ideas segue into others, but most of them are distinct and separate - so I'm hoping that you'll discuss them as separate ideas, rather than just throwing the whole letter into the trash after talking about a few of the ideas.

IDEA Number 1

I think it could be instructive to take a look at the parallel in bridge (the card game).

For many years, the ACBL (American Contract Bridge League) was losing members like crazy. They started doing something about it a few years ago and it's really turned their declining membership around.

Why not have some of the top people in square dancing talk with knowledgeable people at the ACBL and see if any of their ideas might apply to Square Dancing?

Some of the things they did:

"Zero Tolerance" - Essentially this is to make the game less cutthroat and more fun.
"Easy Bridge" - It's less intimidating for beginners to get started, and even to continue. Some people just don't want to play at the cutthroat level, they just want to have fun.

Paybacks/incentives to clubs to retain/get new members - This idea could certainly be used for Square Dancing (Clubs).

Schools: they specifically sent people into the local schools to get children interested

Church Groups: Youth

Church Groups: Adult and Senior

David Silber is the CEO there and he is doing most of the work in trying to retain and get new members. He seems to be very good at this kind of thing. Bridge has a monthly magazine 'The Bulletin'. Often Mr. Silber's monthly article discusses what he's been doing to retain/get members. This month's article discusses the incentives to clubs.

IDEA Number 1A

There's another article in this month's Bridge Bulletin which discusses how the ACBL is talking with a "sports promoter" his name is Larry King. He's promoted other 'sports' such as women's tennis and greatly increased the number of people interested/playing it.

Most people do not think of bridge as a sport, but it is competitive.

I know that Square Dancing is not competitive, but maybe some of the ideas from Larry King could be used for Square Dancing. And/or maybe he would have "different" ideas for how to promote an "activity" rather than a competitive "sport".

It may be worth at least talking to this guy.

I have no idea how much the ACBL is paying this guy (if anything, that is), either, he may cost way more than you're willing to spend.

However, if not this "promoter", maybe there is another professional promoter whose specialty is promoting "activities" and maybe there would be a good source of knowledge/ ideas to tap.

IDEA Number 1B Which segues into the next idea: You are a "FLORIDA" association. Wouldn't you have more money and more clout and more ideas if you got together with callers associations from OTHER STATES? More heads are better than one and more money may enable you all to do more than just each state doing things individually. Individually, you may not have the money to do things, you may be missing the best ideas, you may be wasting money and time duplicating effort. How about a joint effort? If the states' associations try to work together, maybe your ideas and dollars would go further.

IDEA Number 2

As a side idea related to #1, since so many retirees play bridge, and they are also trying to retain/get new members, maybe there is a way to benefit BOTH bridge and

Square Dancing by some sort of joint effort between you and the ACBL ? Or maybe a cross pollination effort?

Something like you and the ACBL (or you [and the local square dance clubs] and the local Bridge Clubs) getting together in a joint effort: bridge players invited to and introduced to Square Dancing while your members are introduced to bridge? Maybe FREE Square Dance lessons for "bridge players" from XXX Bridge Clubs at yyy Square Dance Clubs and recipocally FREE lessons for "Square Dancers" from yyy SD Clubs at XXX Bridge Clubs?

IDEA Number 2 A

Note that: Bridge doesn't have to be the only retiree activity that this is done. There ' s other card games, other activities, etc.

IDEA Number 3

"Bring a Friend" Event. It might be a day, week, particular dance, whatever. But the idea is: Publicize that you are going to have this event where you want dancers to bring a non-dancing friend. It's a SPECIAL dance - you expect to have many non-dancing people there, simply to get people interested. It's FREE, at least for the non-dancers (and probable for the dancers, too, if possible). So you'll have nice friendly dancers there who will talk to these people and be "friendly" (there's that word again) and say

how much fun they have and even maybe suggest they try a few lessons. They can come over and talk to the people - don't just leave them sitting alone in a corner. Introduce yourselves, and introduce the non-dancers TO EACH other - more friendships.

IDEA Number 3A

The format of the "Bring a Friend" Event is important: First, the caller would call some 'real' tips that the 'real' dancers will dance to, which will show how much fun they have dancing. "Hey, that looks like fun". But also important is that you INCLUDE/INVOLVE the non-dancers (that's why they are there, right?) So you must call at least a few tips with some of the non-dancers *REALLY EASY* just so that they get up on the floor, enjoy themselves, and can see it's fun: and *EXTREMELY IMPORTANT* that no one yells at them when they make a mistake. If a dancer can't be nice to someone new, they shouldn't attend this event. All they will do is drive people away. People need to remember that they were once new themselves and they didn't like it when people yelled or made faces - so don't do it to someone else. Especially when the event was PROMOTED as "a chance to have non-dancers see what it's like" - so that the dancers will know ahead of time that there will be non-dancers there and to be friendly and tolerant. (Don't
