Several of our members attended the National Convention in Minnesota.

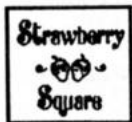
We'll be looking forward to dancing with you at the Knothead Konvention Labor Day weekend.

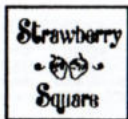
