SIGNIFICANCE OF THE DEADLINE

Did you ever wonder why the Deadline for articles, changes and Ads is almost a month prior to the folding of the magazine? Well, first, we need about a week, sometimes more to make all the changes. Even though about 90% of the layout is pre-determined, it's the last 10% that requires the most time.

We reformat Ads that don't fit the page and rearrange the page layout to accommodate late information that does not fit in available blank spaces. Many times additional information requires enlarging an entire layout, pushing other data off the page. Moving items from one page to another several times is not uncommon. If there is a 1/2 page blank, you can bet the next item will require 3/4 of a page.

Second, after everything comes together, the Dummy is printed and taken to the Printer. The Printer needs a 7 to 10 work day lead time. Seasonal work load is the factor here just as the season affects our dance attendance.

Then there is the Dropdead Deadline, a date just prior to printing the Dummy. This is the date when we positively, absolutely and under any circumstances, cannot accept any more changes or additions. Fortunately, informing someone of this date is seldom required.

And then, a couple of days are needed to prepare the printed copies for the folding. We also like to make sure any flyer inserts are all ready, and some collating and stapling is done beforehand. This allows more time for the incidentals that come up at the folding and they usually do.

Thanks to those who get their copy to us prior to or near the deadline.
