

- 12 states – Red bar
- 24 states – White bar
- 36 states – Blue bar
- 48 states – Silver bar
- 50 states – Gold bar

No duplication of states is permitted. You must visit each of the 50 states.

Badges and bars will be presented at the annual USDA meeting which is held during the annual National Square Dance Convention. Any participant who visits 48 or 50 states will also be awarded paid admission(s) to the next National Square Dance Convention.

USDA will maintain records of all participants so you may check to see which states you have or have not visited. Participants traveling as a couple, only need to fill out one form, with both names on it.



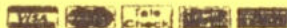
