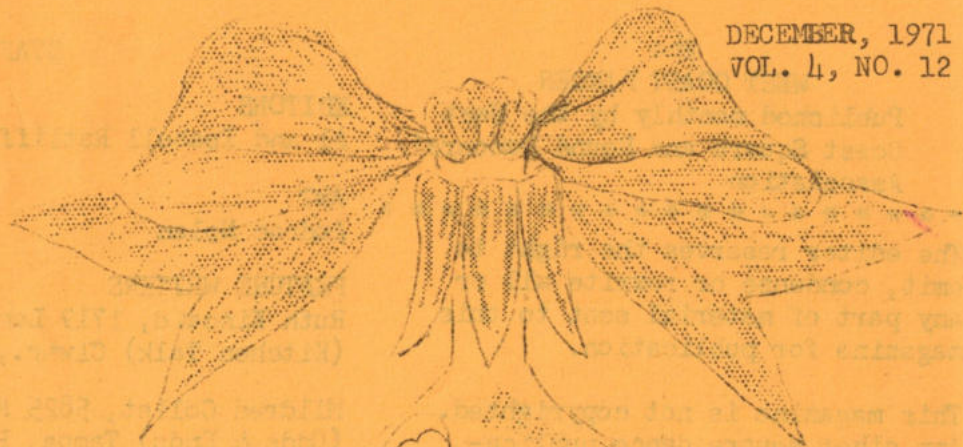
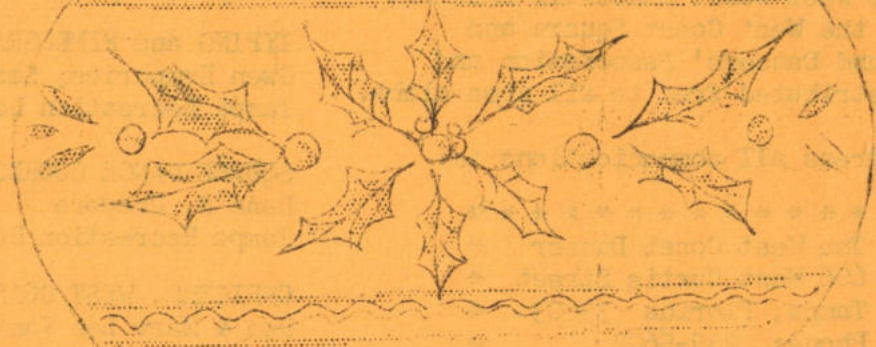

TABLE TALK

CHOCOLATE CHIP CAKE

- 1 C Chopped Dates
- 1 t Soda
- 1 1/2 C Boiling Water

Pour boiling water over dates and soda and let cool

- 3/4 C Oleo
- 2 Eggs (beaten)
- 1 C Sugar
- 1 t Vanilla

Cream all four items together

- 1 1/2 C Flour plus 2 T
- 3/4 t Soda
- 1/4 t Salt

Sift flour, soda, salt together "twice"

Combine flour mixture with creamed sugar mixture alternating with the cooled date mixture; starting and ending with flour. Pour into a 9" x 11" pan greased and floured lightly. Cover with one small package of semi-sweet chocolate chips, 1/2-C chopped nuts and then sprinkle granulated sugar over entire top-just lightly. Bake for 35 to 40 minutes in 350 degree oven. "NOTE" This is a moist cake, so be sure it is done.

KRINGLE COOKIES

- 1 C Oleo
- 1/4 C Sugar
- 2 C Flour
- 1 C Chopped Nuts
- 1 t Vanilla
- Red & Green Decorators Sugar

Cream oleo and sugar; blend in vanilla. Add flour and nuts; mix well. Shape level tablespoonsful of dough into balls; roll in colored sugar. Place on greased baking sheets. Bake at 300 degrees 25 to 30 minutes. Remove immediately from baking sheets. Makes 3 dozen.

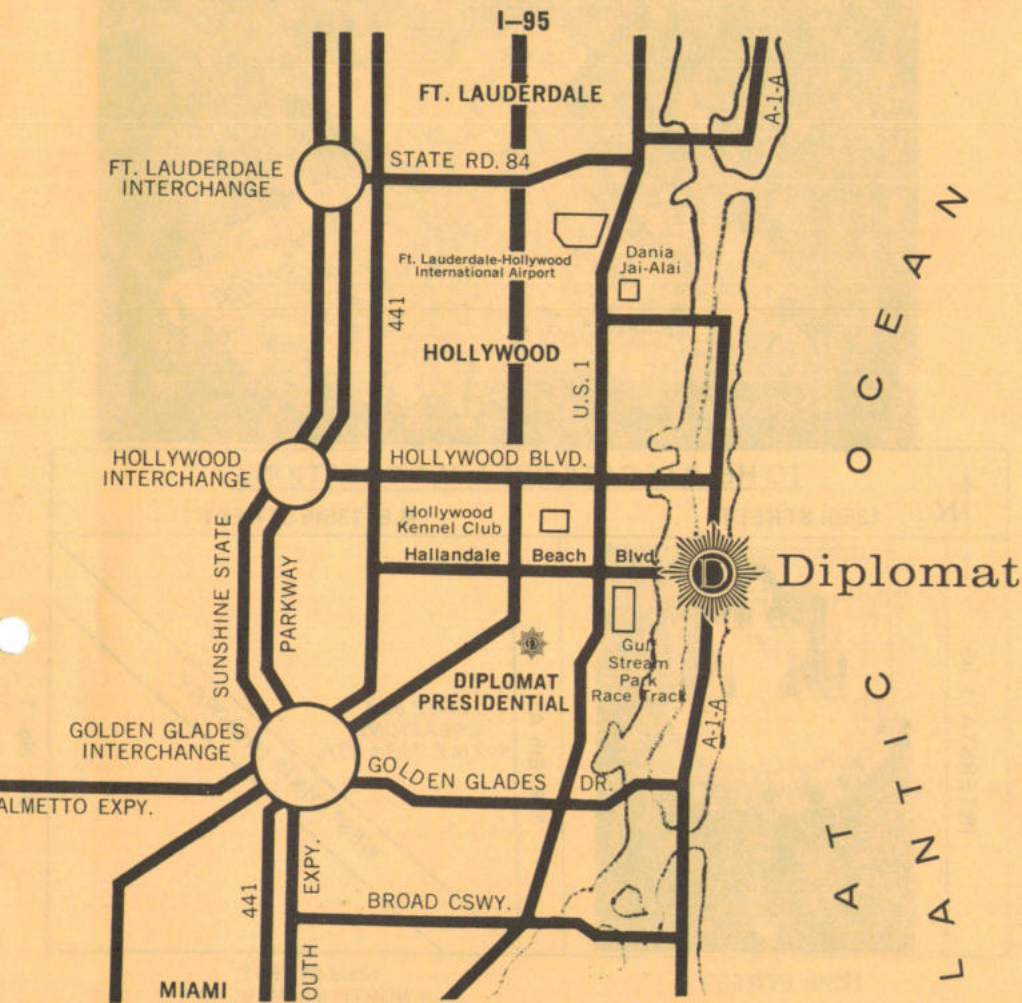
