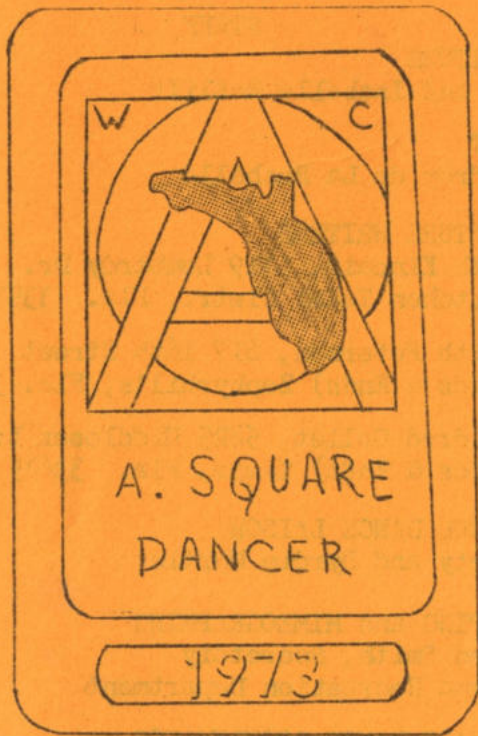

KITCHEN TALK

CHICKEN MEDLEY CASSEROLE

- 1 chicken
 - 2 C celery
 - ? medium onions, chopped
 - 1/2 C sliced almonds
 - 1/2 C ripe olives, chopped
 - 1 large can evaporated milk
 - 1 can pimentos, chopped
 - 1 T worcestershire sauce
 - 1/2 lb. processed cheese
 - 1 C buttered bread crumbs
 - 5 T flour
 - 1/2 t salt
 - 1/4 t pepper
- 2 1/2 C seashell macaroni, cook until tender. Stew chicken until tender, cool and remove meat, cut into small pieces. Cook chopped onions and celery in broth. Measure broth, add water if necessary, to make three cups. Mix flour and milk add to broth, heat and stir until thick, add cheese, stir to melt, add salt, pepper, chicken, olives, pimentos, almonds, worcestershire sauce. Stir until well blended then pour over cooked macaroni. Cover with buttered crumbs. Bake 30 minutes in 350 degree oven.

BARBECUE GREEN BEANS

- 4 slices bacon finely cut
 - 1/4 C chopped onions
 - 1/2 C catsup
 - 1/4 C brown sugar
 - 1 T worcestershire sauce
 - 2 cans French style green beans, drained
- Brown bacon and onions in skillet, add catsup, brown sugar and worcestershire sauce. Simmer 2 minutes. Place beans in casserole, pour bacon mixture over top; but do not stir. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes. Serves 6 to 8.
