Dear Editor,

Your article on page 3 Nov. 78 West Coast Dancer asked for "Caller Opinion." Our viewpoint is that there should be a place for all types of dancers. We're trying to fill one gap we find in the Tampa area with an extended basic club that dances contras and easy rounds as well as squares.

People come and people go but so far as we can determine the only ones lost completely to square dancing are the few that rushed off to every club and workshop they could find. Some of these burned themselves out in less than two years.

No, we don't get the drop-outs from other clubs. Beginners frozen out of their first club are so bitter they refuse to take a chance again. After all, they know what clubs and callers are like --- they've been in one and found that even their own teacher ignored them when they came into a club. So there is no way they'll ever believe it is any different anywhere else. They're simply lost to our activity forever.
