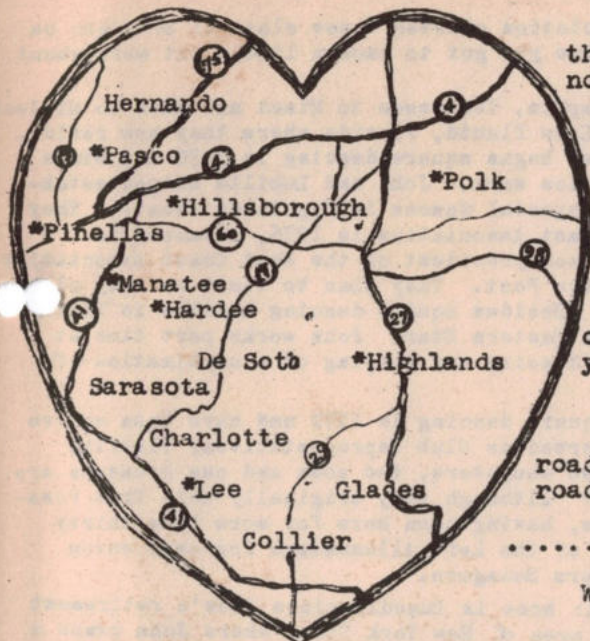
COLLECTOR'S ITEM
