DEC 84

1984 Yearly Report
North Boulevard Meeting
September 30, 1984

Some blood banks made a drastic change in the operation of the blood credit accounts April 1, 1984.

Community, Hunter and Tampa General Blood Banks discontinued transferring donor credits to all organizational accounts. Now, they charge no patient a non-replacement fee, but charge all patients a \$43.00 processing fee whether the patient has a credit account or not.

No donor credits are transferred from out-of-town blood banks to West Coast Association's account. Only donations made at Community Blood Bank's main location or the branch location on Park Boulevard, Pinellas Park are credited to WCA's account.

169 donations were made and credited to WCA's account in 1983.

As of September 1, 1984, WCA's account has 571 credits.

Since the WCA's Blood Bank was organized, 962 donations have been made in the Association's interest, but since April 1, 1984 forty (40) of these donations were not transferred to the account.

The donors continue to support the blood needs of the community.

LEGACY DANCER SURVEY

The centerfold this month is the 3rd biennial dancer survey conducted by LEGACY. In 1980 about 1,000 were returned, in 1982 over 5400 came back and this year our hopes are to triple that amount.

With sufficient returns and comparing these with those of previous surveys, trends may be spotted. These trends can then be used to alert our activity. The data from a large number of dancers from all areas could be used in publications, leadership seminars and caller/cuer clinics. as an authentic voice of the dancer. You will be telling us something and it will be up to the leaders to listen to what you have to say and most important, take some action.

LEGACY is composed of about 200 leaders from every segment of the square dance movement. They have regular biennial meetings for communication and to exchange ideas. The ideas and resolutions are widely publicized for the information of the square dance population. LEGACY is deeply involved in education through Mini-LEGACIES and panels at the Nationals. They publish a leadership manual, maintain a talent bank, hot-line phones and dancer contacts in every state. These names are published in The Square Dance Directory and frequently in other publications.

The results of this survey and how we can make use of it will be the subject of a two hour panel at the National in Birmingham.

WORK/SHOP SUGGESTIONS:

As we promised, more on Latin Figures, as taken from the URDC REFERENCE MANUAL.

HOCKEY STICK - (Rumba)

The Hockey Stick takes its name from the shape of the W's steps which, when followed, resembles a hockey stick.

The figure is used in Rumba and Cha Cha - the difference is the number of steps used and the timing. The preceding figure should end with couple in the Fan position. In this instance the man is facing Wall, weight on R, with his L and W's R hands joined. The Woman is facing Rlod, weight on L, with R ft slightly forward. This is the Fan ending position.

CUE TERM: "HOCKEY STICK"

MAN:

- B-F Q 1. Fwd L small step,
- B-F Q 2. Rec R commence leading Ptr fwd with L hand,
- B-F S 3. Cl L to R raising L arm,-;
- B-F Q 4. Bk R small step,
- B-F Q 5. Rec L at same time lead W to trn her L and lower raised arm,
- B-F S 6. Trn R 1/8 fwd short step R retaining W's L hnd,-;

WOMAN:

- B-F Q 1. Close R to L,
- B-F Q 2. Fwd L,
- B-F S 3. Fwd R raising R arm-;
- B-F Q 4. Fwd L trn toe L 1/8 trn,
- B-F Q 5. Trn L under M's L arm making 3/8 trn stepping slightly Bk and to the side facg LOD,
- B-F S 6. Continue LF trn for another 1/8 Back L to fc Ptr-;

These are the 'guide lines' for the Hockey Stick.

We'd like to add a few additional thoughts that refine the Hockey Stick:- FAN position - M's L hand is palm UP with W's R hand in his palm. Partners are close enough that elbows are slightly bent, and arms are tensed. The reason for this is so that the M can lead the W (with his L arm) using a slight pressure (hoping her arm is firm too) toward her, causing her to close her R ft to her L.

The W's fan position should have had her toes pointing diag.R/W so that when the M leads her to close her R to L, she automatically swivels and her toes will point RLOD for her next step.

Also for the M...on his "6" we like to see him follow her right out, giving her the freedom of a good step backward to create the image of a hockey stick. For the W on "5", she can bring her L arm across her body to make a compact LF trn and then on "6" extend that arm to the side.

We'll continue with more "latins"...watch for us...The power of the URDC Pyramid is working for YOU! We want you to have fun with your dancing.....
